

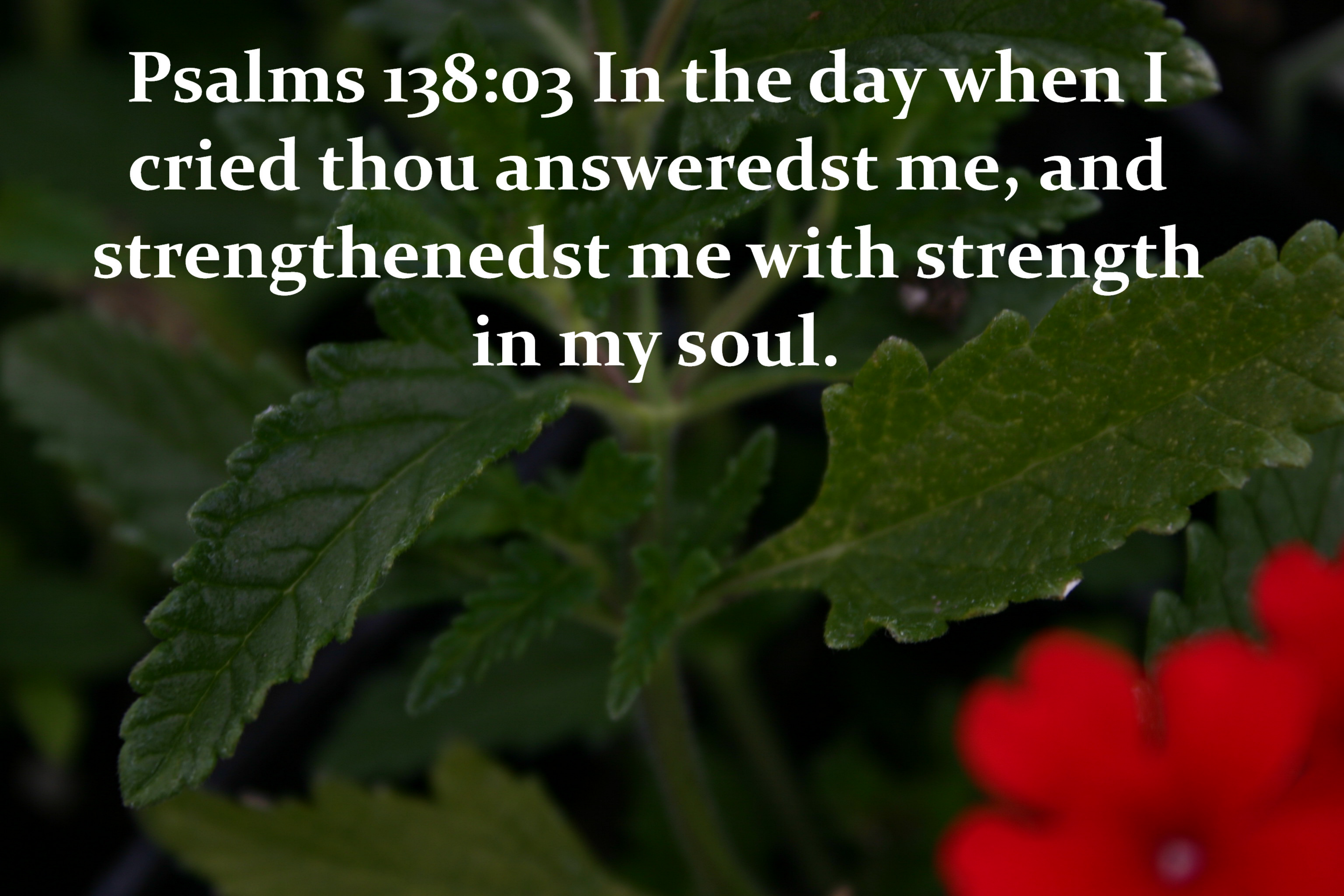


**Psalms 138:01 A Psalm of David. I

in my soul.**



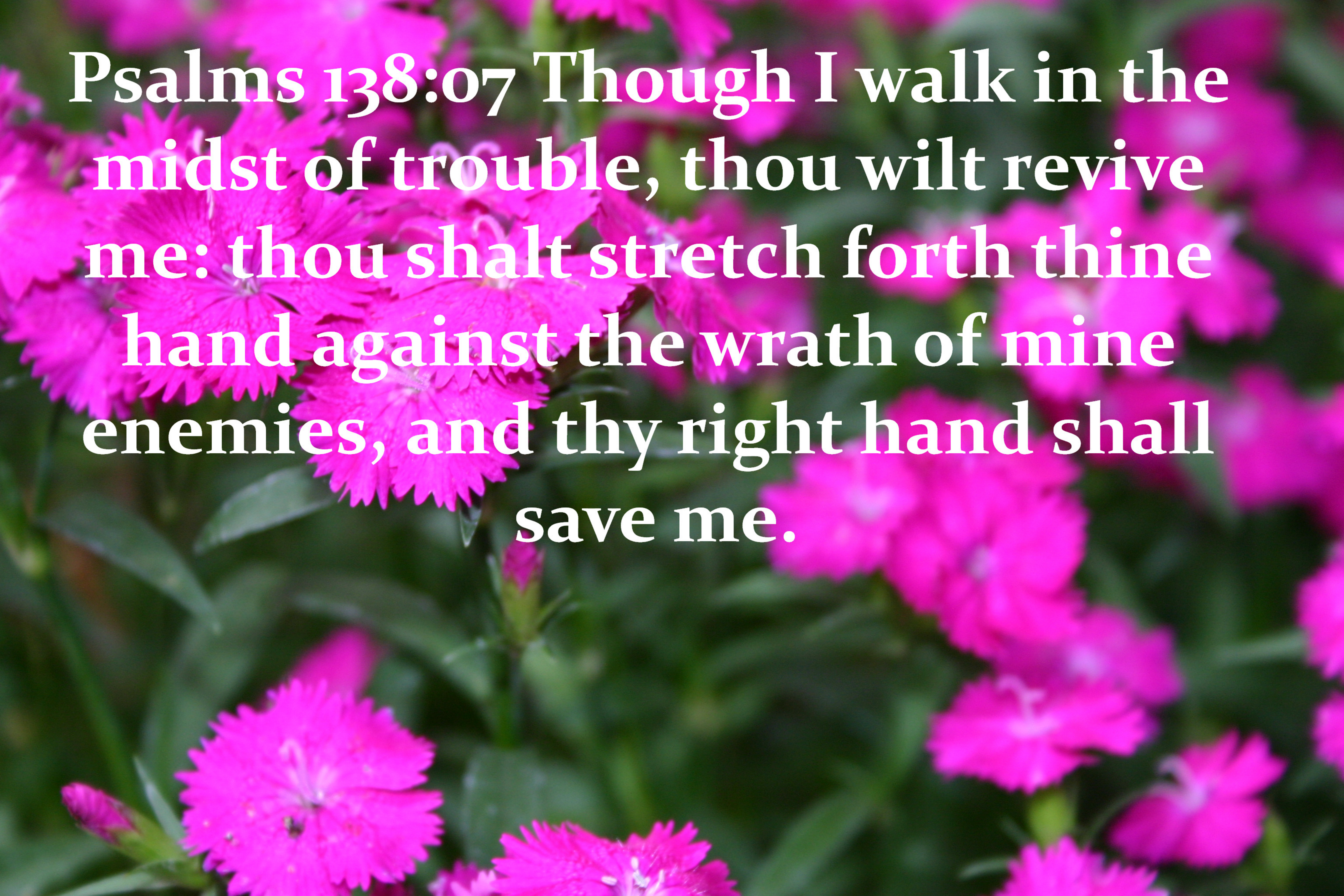
**Psalms 138:04 All the kings of the
