18 JOB 24 01 Why, seeing times are not hidden from the Almighty, do they that know him not see his days? 18 JOB 24 02 [Some] remove the landmarks; they violently take away flocks, and feed [thereof]. 18 JOB 24 03 They drive away the ass of the fatherless, they take the widow's ox for a pledge. 18 JOB 24 04 They turn the needy out of the way: the poor of the earth hide themselves together. 18 JOB 24 05 Behold, [as] wild asses in the desert, go they forth to their work; rising betimes for a prey: the wilderness [yieldeth] food for them [and] for [their] children. 18 JOB 24 06 They reap [every one] his corn in the field: and they gather the vintage of the wicked.

18 JOB 24 07 They cause the naked to lodge without clothing, that [they have] no covering in the cold.

18 JOB 24 08 They are wet with the showers of the mountains, and embrace the rock for want of a shelter.

18 JOB 24 09 They pluck the fatherless from the breast, and take a pledge of the poor.

18 JOB 24 10 They cause [him] to go naked without clothing, and they take away the sheaf [from] the hungry;

18 JOB 24 11 [Which] make oil within their walls, [and] tread [their] winepresses, and suffer thirst.

18 JOB 24 12 Men groan from out of the city, and the soul of the wounded crieth out: yet God layeth not folly [to them].

18 JOB 24 13 They are of those that rebel against the light; they know not the ways thereof, nor abide in the paths thereof.

18 JOB 24 14 The murderer rising with the light killeth the poor and needy, and in the night is as a thief.

18 JOB 24 15 The eye also of the adulterer waiteth for the twilight, saying, No eye shall see me: and disguiseth [his] face.

18 JOB 24 16 In the dark they dig through houses, [which] they had marked for themselves in the daytime: they know not the light.

18 JOB 24 17 For the morning [is] to them even as the shadow of death: if [one] know [them, they are in] the terrors of the shadow of death.

18 JOB 24 18 He [is] swift as the waters; their portion is cursed in the earth: he beholdeth not the way of the vineyards.

18 JOB 24 19 Drought and heat consume the snow waters: [so doth] the grave [those which] have sinned.

18 JOB 24 20 The womb shall forget him; the worm shall feed sweetly on him; he shall be no more remembered; and wickedness shall be broken as a tree.

18 JOB 24 21 He evil entreateth the barren [that] beareth not: and doeth not good to the widow.

18 JOB 24 22 He draweth also the mighty with his power: he riseth up, and no [man] is sure of life.

18 JOB 24 23 [Though] it be given him [to be] in safety, whereon he resteth; yet his eyes [are] upon their ways.

18_JOB_24_24 They are exalted for a little while, but are gone and brought low; they are taken out of the way as all [other], and cut off as the tops of the ears of corn.

18 JOB 24 25 And if [it be] not [so] now, who will make me a liar, and make my speech nothing worth?
