

Complete KJV Holy Bible

- 18 JOB 33 01 Wherefore, Job, I pray thee, hear my speeches, and hearken to all my words.
- 18 JOB 33 02 Behold, now I have opened my mouth, my tongue hath spoken in my mouth.
- 18 JOB 33 03 My words [shall be of] the uprightness of my heart: and my lips shall utter knowledge clearly.
- 18 JOB 33 04 The spirit of God hath made me, and the breath of the Almighty hath given me life.
- 18 JOB 33 05 If thou canst answer me, set [thy words] in order before me, stand up.
- 18 JOB 33 06 Behold, I [am] according to thy wish in God's stead: I also am formed out of the clay.
- 18 JOB 33 07 Behold, my terror shall not make thee afraid, neither shall my hand be heavy upon thee.
- 18 JOB 33 08 Surely thou hast spoken in mine hearing, and I have heard the voice of [thy] words, [saying],
- 18 JOB 33 09 I am clean without transgression, I [am] innocent; neither [is there] iniquity in me.
- 18 JOB 33 10 Behold, he findeth occasions against me, he counteth me for his enemy,
- 18_JOB_33_11 He putteth my feet in the stocks, he marketh all my paths.
- 18 JOB 33 12 Behold, [in] this thou art not just: I will answer thee, that God is greater than man.
- 18 JOB 33 13 Why dost thou strive against him? for he give h not account of any of his matters.
- 18 JOB 33 14 For God speaketh once, yea twice, [yet man] perceiveth it not.
- 18 JOB 33 15 In a dream, in a vision of the night, when deep sleep falleth upon men, in slumberings upon the bed;
- 18 JOB 33 16 Then he openeth the ears of men, and sealeth their instruction,
- 18_JOB_33_17 That he may withdraw man [from his] purpose, and hide pride from man.
- 18 JOB 33 18 He keepeth back his soul from the pit, and his life from perishing by the sword.
- 18 JOB 33 19 He is chastened also with pain upon his bed, and the multitude of his bones with strong [pain]:
- 18_JOB_33_20 So that his life abhorreth bread, and his soul dainty meat.

18 JOB 33 21 His flesh is consumed away, that it cannot be seen; and his bones [that] were not seen stick out.

18 JOB 33 22 Yea, his soul draweth near unto the grave, and his life to the destroyers.

18 JOB 33 23 If there be a messenger with him, an interpreter, one among a thousand, to show unto man his uprightness:

18_JOB_33_24 Then he is gracious unto him, and saith, Deliver him from going down to the pit: I have found a ransom.

18 JOB 33 25 His flesh shall be fresher than a child's: he shall return to the days of his youth:

18 JOB 33 26 He shall pray unto God, and he will be favourable unto him: and he shall see his face with joy: for he will render unto man his righteousness.

18 JOB 33 27 He looketh upon men, and [if any] say, I have sinned, and perverted [that which was] right, and it profited me not;

18 JOB 33 28 He will deliver his soul from going into the pit, and his life shall see the light.

18 JOB 33 29 Lo, all these [things] worketh God oftentimes with man,

18 JOB 33 30 To bring back his soul from the pit, to be enlightened with the light of the living.

18 JOB 33 31 Mark well, O Job, hearken unto me: hold thy peace, and I will speak.

18 JOB 33 32 If thou hast any thing to say, answer me: speak, for I desire to justify thee.

18 JOB 33 33 If not, hearken unto me: hold thy peace, and I shall teach thee wisdom.
