19 PSA 132 04 I will not give sleep to mine eyes, [or] slumber to mine eyelids,

19 PSA 136 10 To him that smote Egypt in their firstborn: for his mercy [endureth] for ever:

19 PSA 136 25 Who giveth food to all flesh: for his mercy [endureth] for ever.

19 PSA 137 02 We hanged our harps upon the willows in the midst thereof.

19 PSA 131 02 Surely I have behaved and quieted myself, as a child that is weaned of his mother: my soul [is] even

19 PSA 138 01 [A Psalm] of David. I will praise thee with my whole heart: before the gods will I sing praise unto

19 PSA 138 02 I will worship toward thy holy temple, and praise thy name for thy lovingkindness and for thy truth:

19 PSA 138 03 In the day when I cried thou answeredst me, [and] strengthenedst me [with] strength in my soul.

19 PSA 138 06 Though the LORD [be] high, yet hath he respect unto the lowly: but the proud he knoweth afar off.

19 PSA 138 07 Though I walk in the midst of trouble, thou wilt revive me: thou shalt stretch forth thine hand against

19 PSA 138 08 The LORD will perfect [that which] concerneth me: thy mercy, O LORD, [endureth] for ever:

19 PSA 139 01 To the chief Musician, A Psalm of David. O LORD, thou hast searched me, and known [me].

19 PSA 139 02 Thou knowest my downsitting and mine uprising, thou understandest my thought afar off.

19_PSA_139_03 Thou compassest my path and my lying down, and art acquainted [with] all my ways.

19 PSA 139 06 [Such] knowledge [is] too wonderful for me; it is high, I cannot [attain] unto it.

19 PSA 139 07 Whither shall I go from thy spirit? or whither shall I flee from thy presence?

19 PSA 139 10 Even there shall thy hand lead me, and thy right hand shall hold me.

19 PSA 139 09 [If] I take the wings of the morning, [and] dwell in the uttermost parts of the sea;

19 PSA 137 09 Happy [shall he be], that taketh and dasheth thy little ones against the stones.

19 PSA 137 01 By the rivers of Babylon, there we sat down, yea, we wept, when we remembered Zion.

19 PSA 139 04 For [there is] not a word in my tongue, [but], lo, O LORD, thou knowest it altogether. 19 PSA 139 05 Thou hast beset me behind and before, and laid thine hand upon me.

19 PSA 139 08 If I ascend up into heaven, thou [art] there: if I make my bed in hell, behold, thou [art there].

19 PSA 139 15 My substance was not hid from thee, when I was made in secret, [and] curiously wrought in the lowest parts of the earth. 19 PSA 139 16 Thine eyes did see my substance, yet being unperfect; and in thy book all [my members] were

19 PSA 139 18 [If] I should count them, they are more in number than the sand: when I awake, I am still with thee.

19_PSA_139_14 I will praise thee; for I am fearfully [and] wonderfully made: marvellous [are] thy works; and [that]

19 PSA 139 12 Yea, the darkness hideth not from thee; but the night shineth as the day: the darkness and the light

19 PSA 139 21 Do not I hate them, O LORD, that hate thee? and am not I grieved with those that rise up against thee? 19 PSA 139 22 I hate them with perfect hatred: I count them mine enemies.

19 PSA 139 23 Search me, O God, and know my heart: try me, and know my thoughts: 19 PSA 139 24 And see if [there be any] wicked way in me, and lead me in the way everlasting.

19 PSA 13 01 To the chief Musician, A Psalm of David. How long wilt thou forget me, O LORD? for ever? how long wilt thou hide thy face from me?

19 PSA 13 02 How long shall I take counsel in my soul, [having] sorrow in my heart daily? how long shall mine enemy be exalted over me? 19 PSA 13 03 Consider [and] hear me, O LORD my God: lighten mine eyes, lest I sleep the [sleep of] death; 19 PSA 13 04 Lest mine enemy say, I have prevailed against him; [and] those that trouble me rejoice when I am

moved. 19 PSA 13 05 But I have trusted in thy mercy; my heart shall rejoice in thy salvation. 19 PSA 13 06 I will sing unto the LORD, because he hath dealt bountifully with me.
