

## **Complete KJV Holy Bible**

19 PSA 44 01 To the chief Musician for the sons of Korah, Maschil. We have heard with our ears, O God, our fathers have told us, [what] work thou didst in their days, in the times of old.

19 PSA 44 02 [How] thou didst drive out the heathen with thy hand, and plantedst them; [how] thou didst afflict the people, and cast them out.

19 PSA 44 03 For they got not the land in possession by their own sword, neither did their own arm save them: but thy right hand, and thine arm, and the light of thy countenance, because thou hadst a favour unto them.

19 PSA 44 04 Thou art my King, O God: command deliverances for Jacob.

19 PSA 44 05 Through thee will we push down our enemies: through thy name will we tread them under that rise up against us.

19 PSA 44 06 For I will not trust in my bow, neither shall my sword save me.

19 PSA 44 07 But thou hast saved us from our enemies, and hast put them to shame that hated us.

19 PSA 44 08 In God we boast all the day long, and praise thy name for ever. Selah.

19 PSA 44 09 But thou hast cast off, and put us to shame; and goest not forth with our armies.

19 PSA 44 10 Thou makest us to turn back from the enemy: and they which hate us spoil for themselves.

19 PSA 44 11 Thou hast given us like sheep [appointed] for meat; and hast scattered us among the heathen.

19 PSA 44 12 Thou sellest thy people for nought, and dost not increase [thy wealth] by their price.

19 PSA 44 13 Thou makest us a reproach to our neighbours, a scorn and a derision to them that are round about us.

19 PSA 44 14 Thou makest us a byword among the heathen, a shaking of the head among the people.

19 PSA 44 15 My confusion [is] continually before me, and the shame of my face hath covered me,

**19** PSA 44 16 For the voice of him that reproacheth and blasphemeth; by reason of the enemy and avenger.

19 PSA 44 17 All this is come upon us; yet have we not forgotten thee, neither have we dealt falsely in thy covenant.

**19 PSA 44 18 Our heart is not turned back, neither have our steps declined from thy way;** 

19\_PSA\_44\_19 Though thou hast sore broken us in the place of dragons, and covered us with the shadow of death.

19 PSA 44 20 If we have forgotten the name of our God, or stretched out our hands to a strange god;

19\_PSA\_44\_21 Shall not God search this out? for he knoweth the secrets of the heart.

19 PSA 44 22 Yea, for thy sake are we killed all the day long; we are counted as sheep for the slaughter.

19 PSA 44 23 Awake, why sleepest thou, O Lord? arise, cast [us] not off for ever.

19 PSA 44 24 Wherefore hidest thou thy face, [and] forgettest our affliction and our oppression?

19 PSA 44 25 For our soul is bowed down to the dust: our belly cleaveth unto the earth.

19 PSA 44 26 Arise for our help, and redeem us for thy mercies' sake.
