**19\_PSA\_63\_01** A Psalm of David, when he was in the wilderness of Judah. O God, thou [art] my God; early will I seek thee: my soul thirsteth for thee, my flesh longeth for thee in a dry and thirsty land, where no water is;

**19\_PSA\_63\_02** To see thy power and thy glory, so [as] I have seen thee in the sanctuary.

**19\_PSA\_63\_03** Because thy lovingkindness [is] better than life, my lips shall praise thee.

**19\_PSA\_63\_04** Thus will I bless thee while I live: I will lift up my hands in thy name.

**19\_PSA\_63\_05** My soul shall be satisfied as [with] marrow and fatness; and my mouth shall praise [thee] with joyful lips:

**19\_PSA\_63\_06** When I remember thee upon my bed, [and] meditate on thee in the [night] watches.

**19\_PSA\_63\_07** Because thou hast been my help, therefore in the shadow of thy wings will I rejoice.

**19\_PSA\_63\_08** My soul followeth hard after thee: thy right hand upholdeth me.

**19\_PSA\_63\_09** But those [that] seek my soul, to destroy [it], shall go into the lower parts of the earth.

**19\_PSA\_63\_10** They shall fall by the sword: they shall be a portion for foxes.

**19\_PSA\_63\_11** But the king shall rejoice in God; every one that sweareth by him shall glory: but the mouth of them that speak lies shall be stopped.
