**19\_PSA\_65\_01** To the chief Musician, A Psalm [and] Song of David. Praise waiteth for thee, O God, in Sion: and unto thee shall the vow be performed.

**19\_PSA\_65\_02** O thou that hearest prayer, unto thee shall all flesh come.

**19\_PSA\_65\_03** Iniquities prevail against me: [as for] our transgressions, thou shalt purge them away.

**19\_PSA\_65\_04** Blessed [is the man whom] thou choolest, and caustest to approach [unto thee, that] he may dwell in thy courts: we shall be satisfied with the goodness of thy house, [even] of thy holy temple.

**19\_PSA\_65\_05** [By] terrible things in righteousness wilt thou answer us, O God of our salvation; [who art] the confidence of all the ends of the earth, and of them that are afar off [upon] the sea:

**19\_PSA\_65\_06** Which by his strength setteth fast the mountains; [being] girded with power:

**19\_PSA\_65\_07** Which stilleth the noise of the seas, the noise of their waves, and the tumult of the people.

**19\_PSA\_65\_08** They also that dwell in the uttermost parts are afraid at thy tokens: thou makest the outgoings of the morning and evening to rejoice.

**19\_PSA\_65\_09** Thou visitest the earth, and waterest it: thou greatly enrichest it with the river of God, [which] is full of water: thou preparest them corn, when thou hast so provided for it.

**19\_PSA\_65\_10** Thou waterest the ridges thereof abundantly: thou settlest the furrows thereof: thou makest it soft with showers: thou blessest the springing thereof.

**19\_PSA\_65\_11** Thou crownest the year with thy goodness; and thy paths drop fatness.

**19\_PSA\_65\_12** They drop [upon] the pastures of the wilderness: and the little hills rejoice on every side.

**19\_PSA\_65\_13** The pastures are clothed with flocks; the valleys also are covered over with corn; they shout for joy, they also sing.
