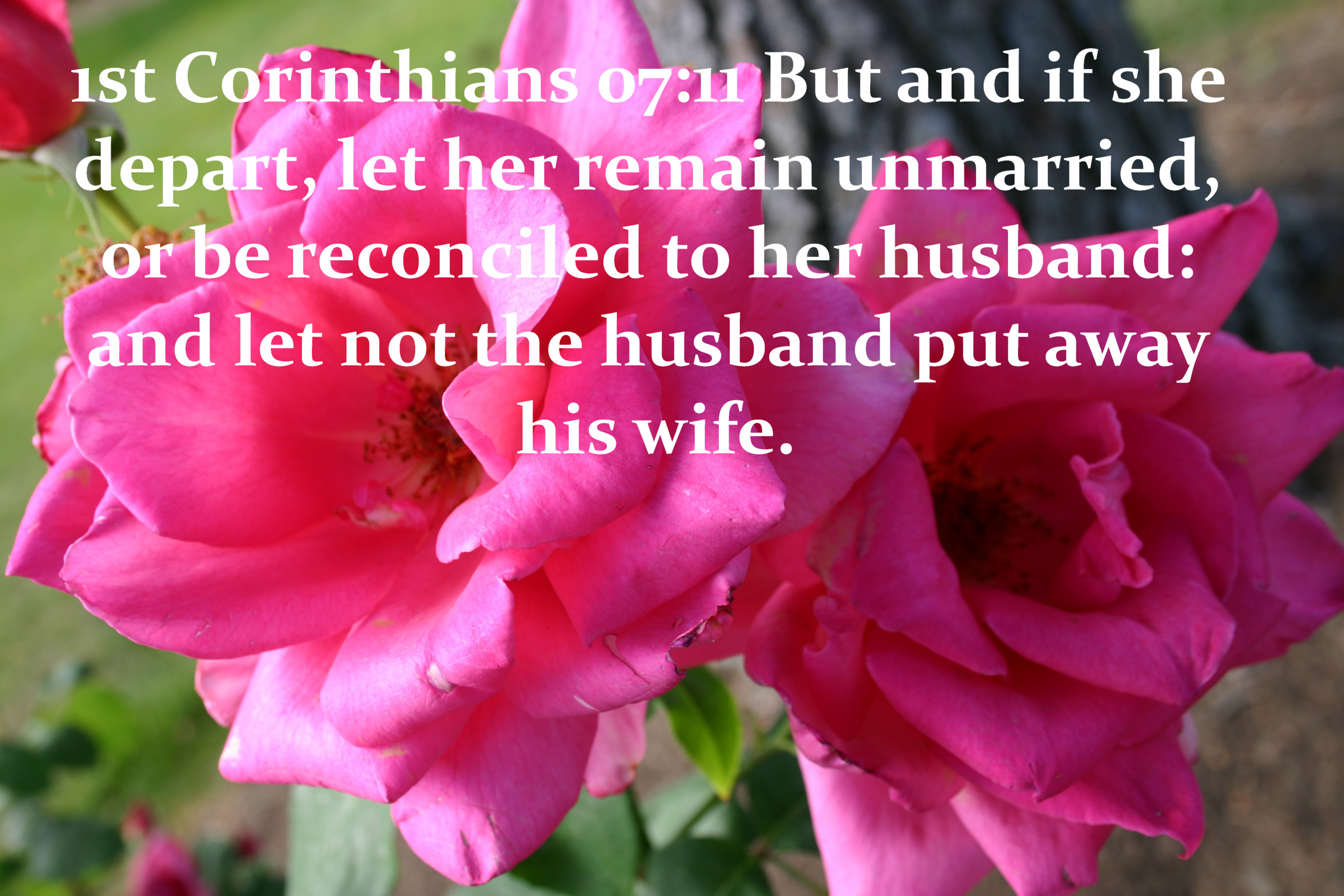

be saved by his life.**

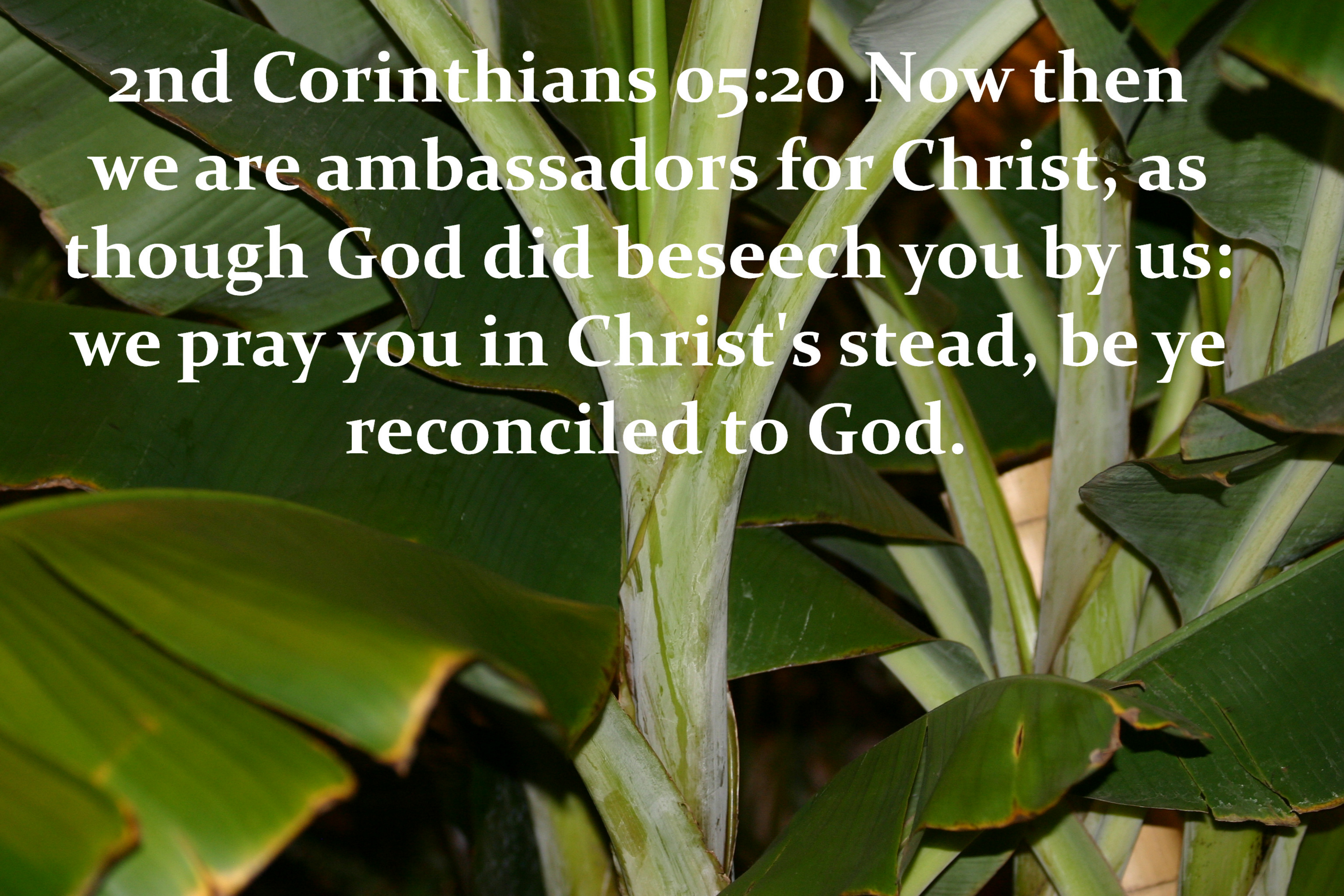
