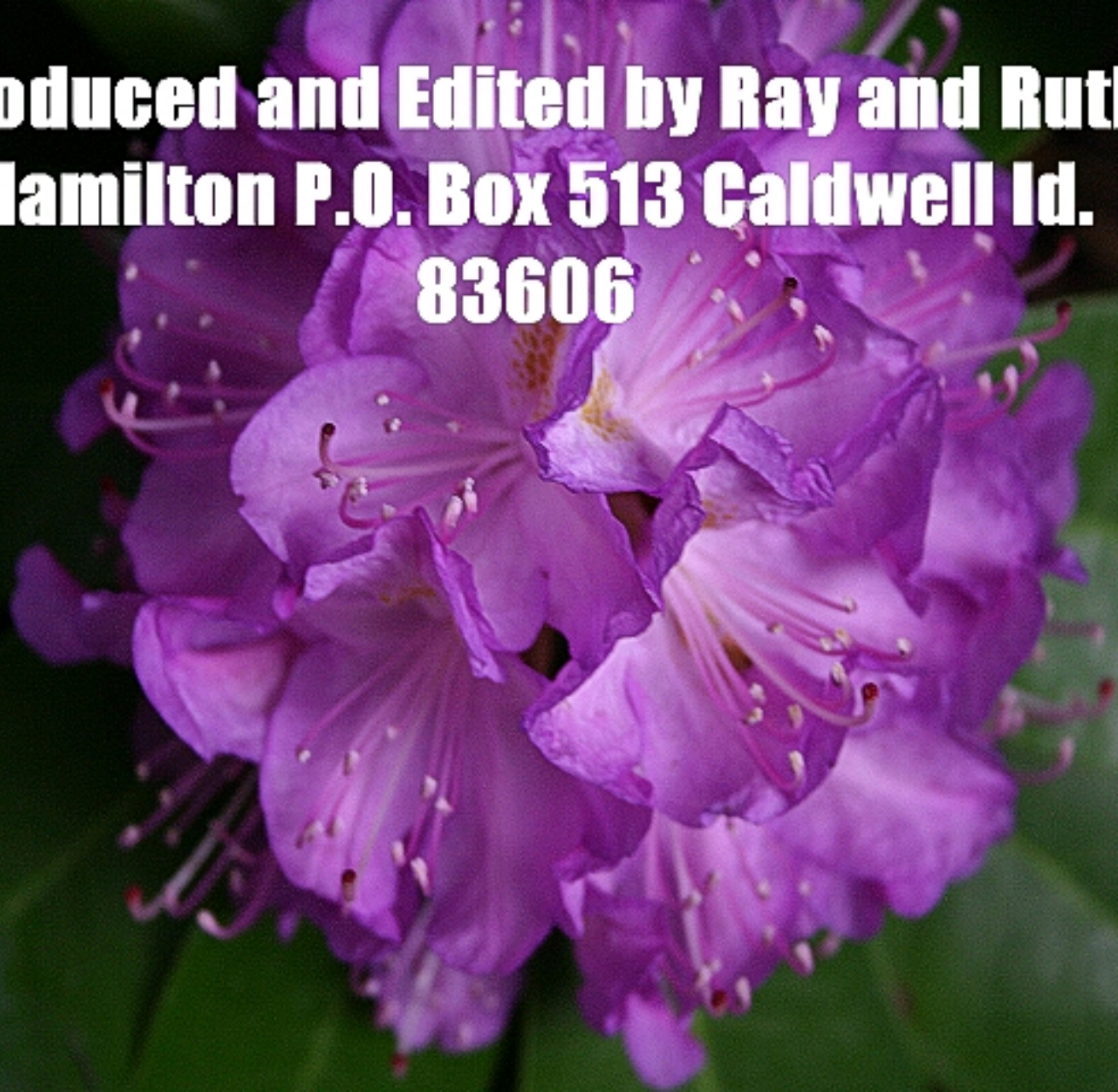


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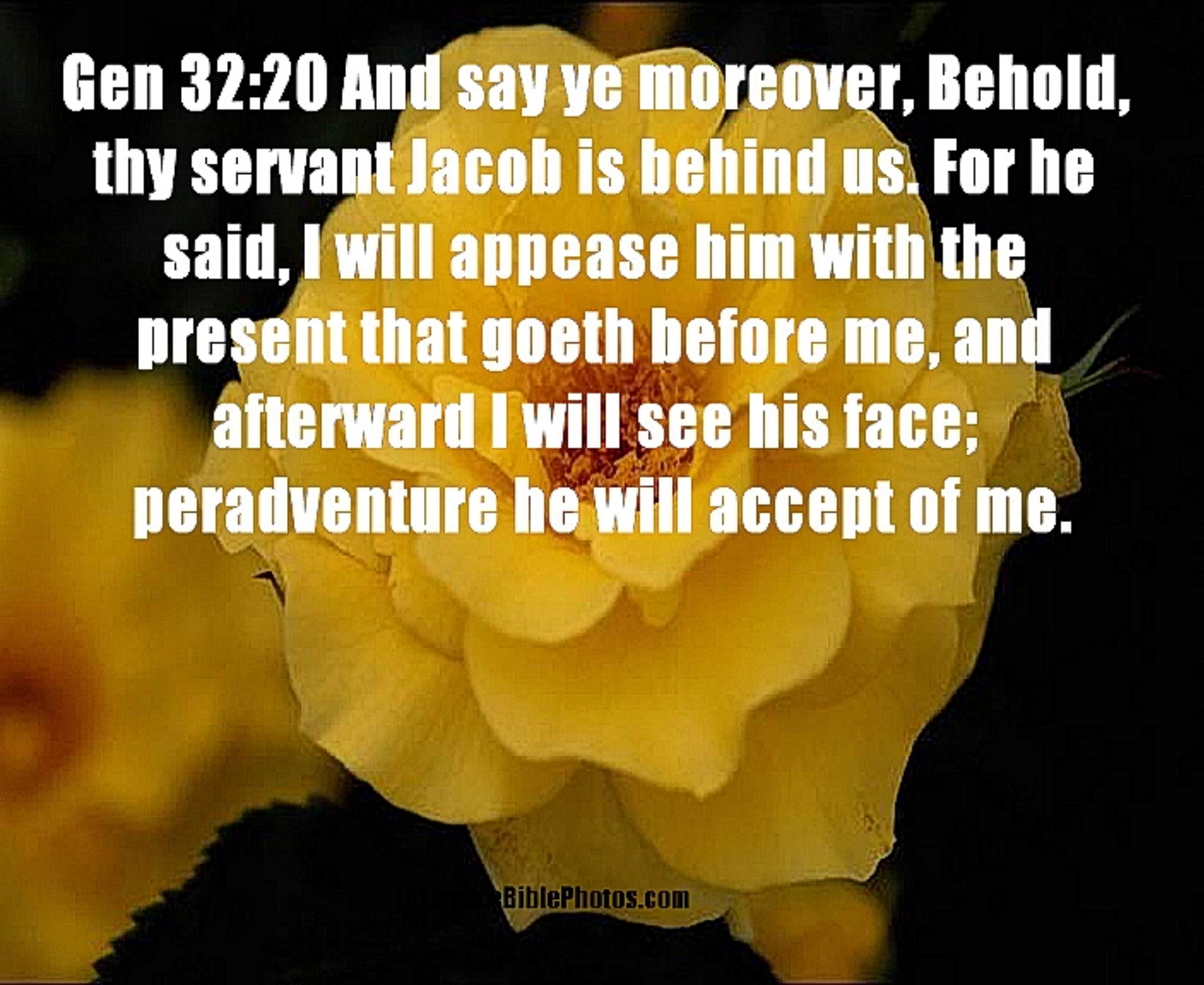

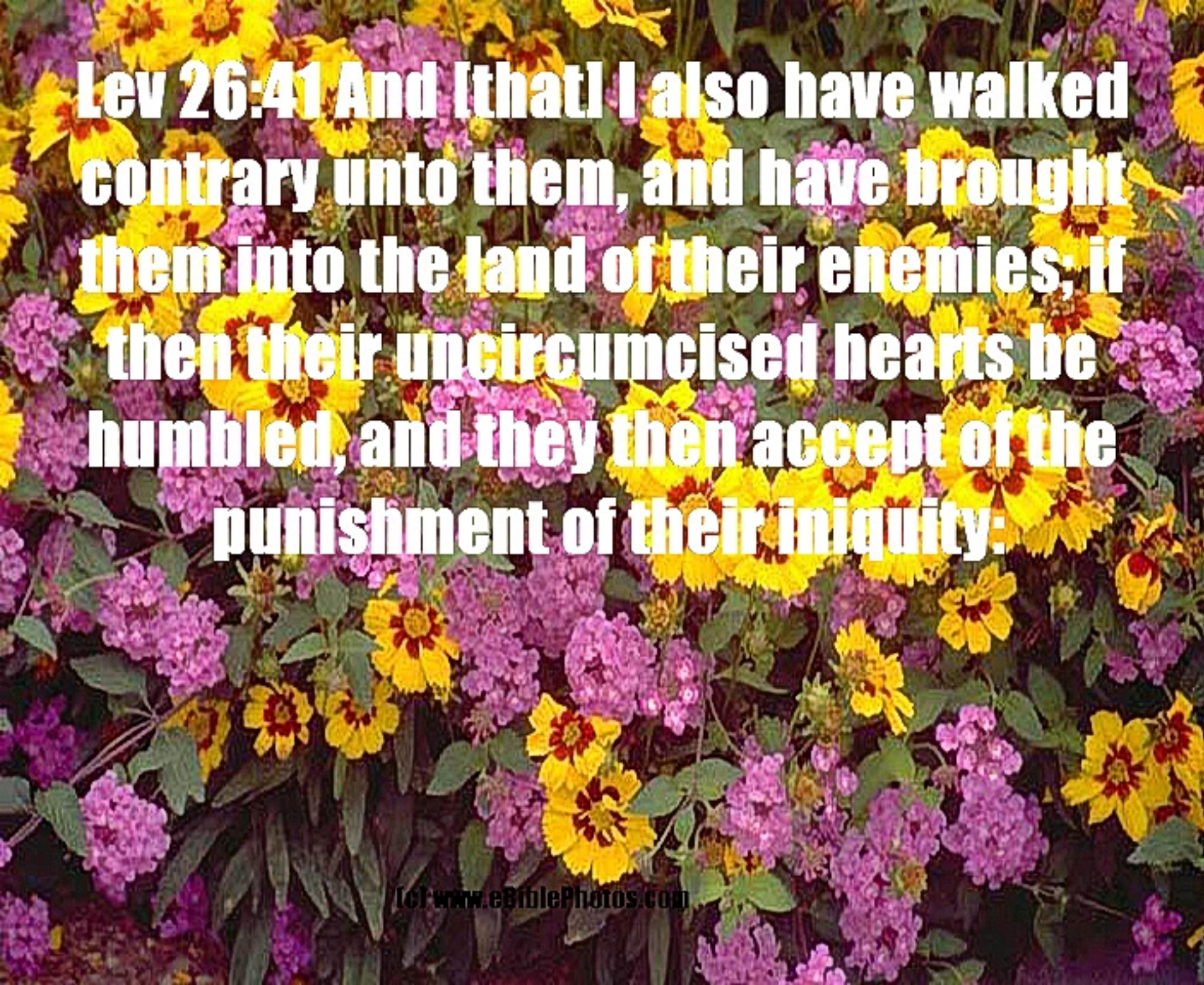




**Gen 32:20 And say ye moreover, Behold,

present that goeth before me, and
afterward I will see his face;
peradventure he will accept of me.**

thereof, and he shall not make it good.**



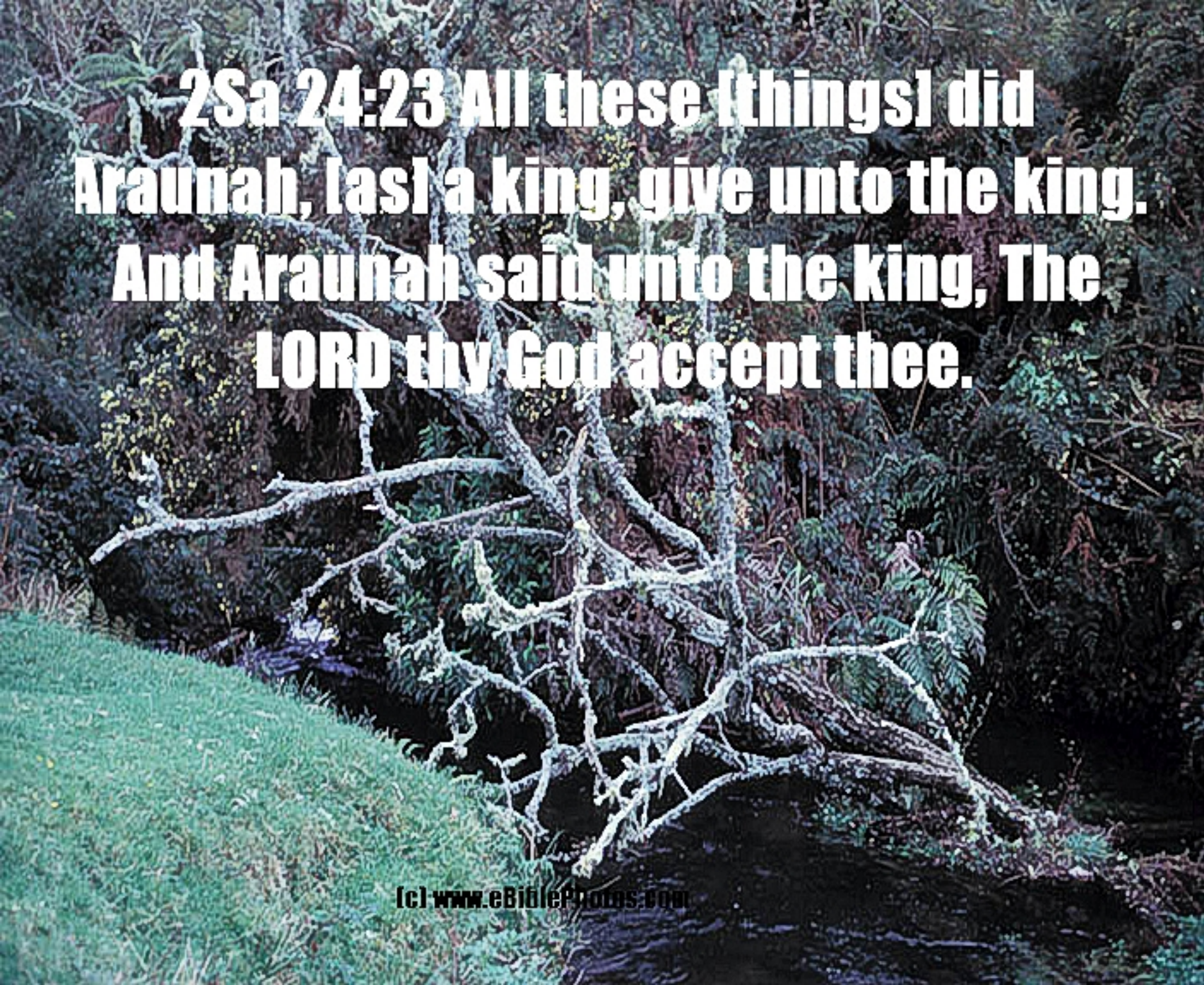
**Lev 26:41 And [that] I also have walked

the wicked? Selah.**

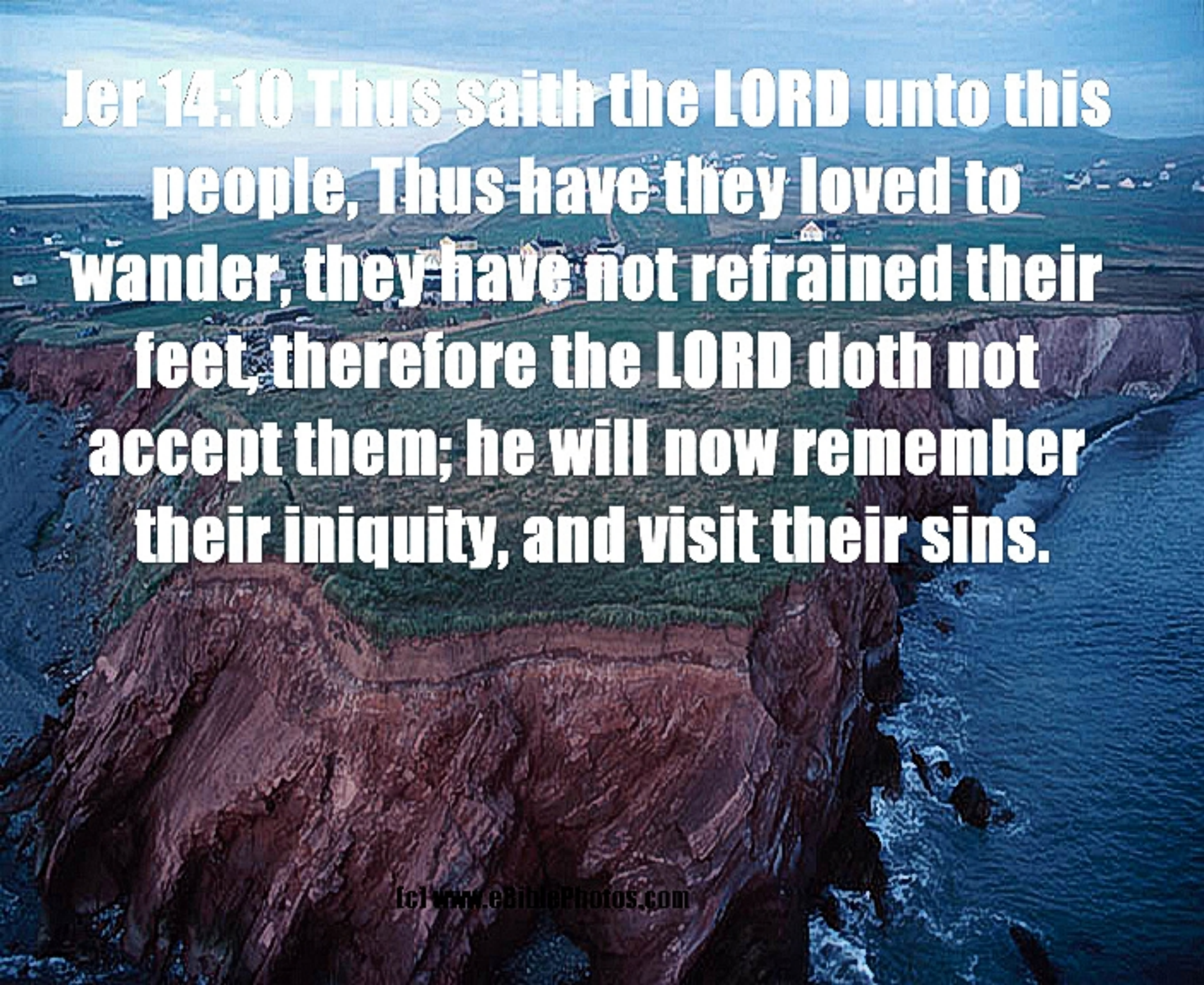


**Psa 119:108 Accept, I beseech thee,

LORD, and teach me thy judgments.**

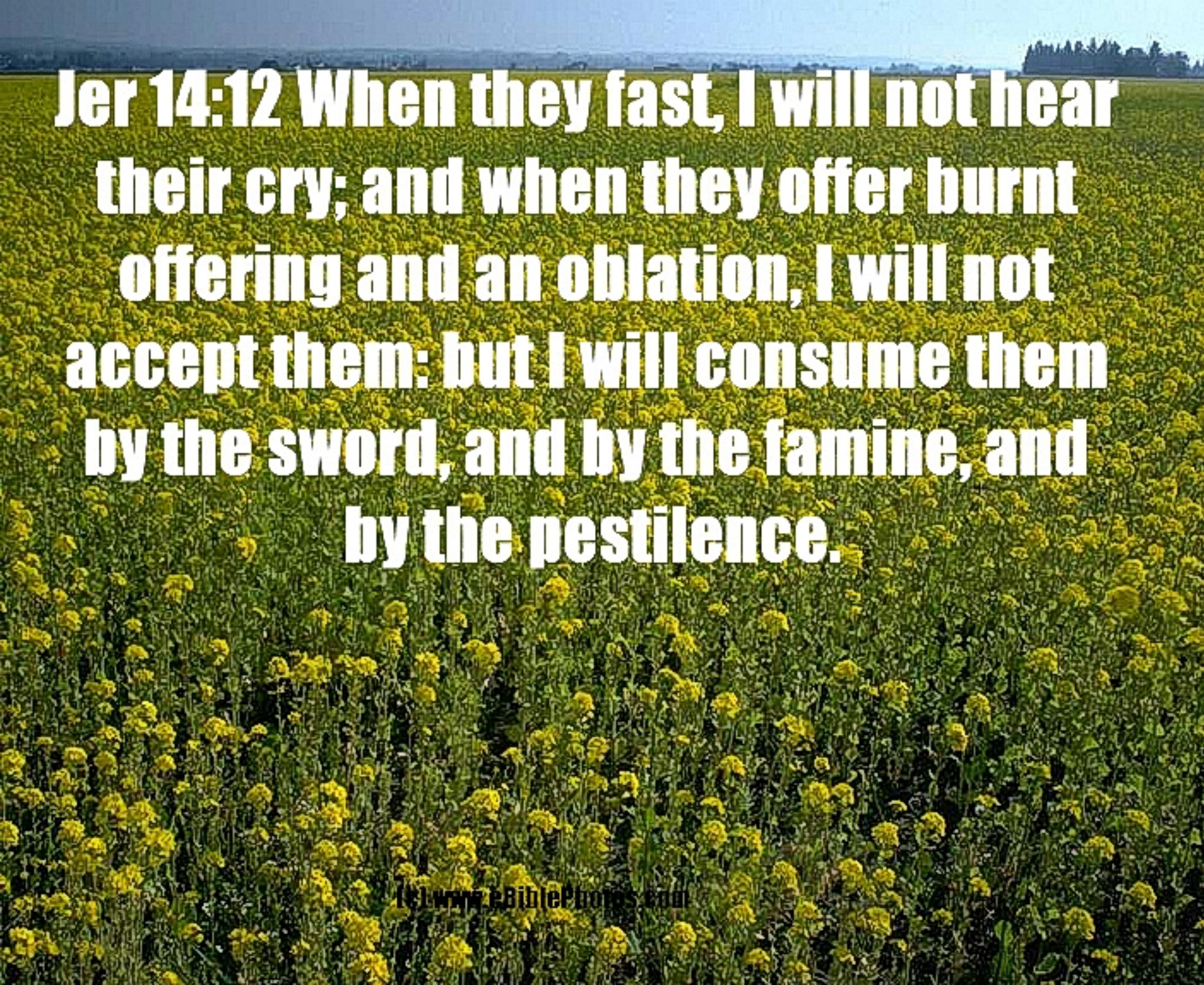

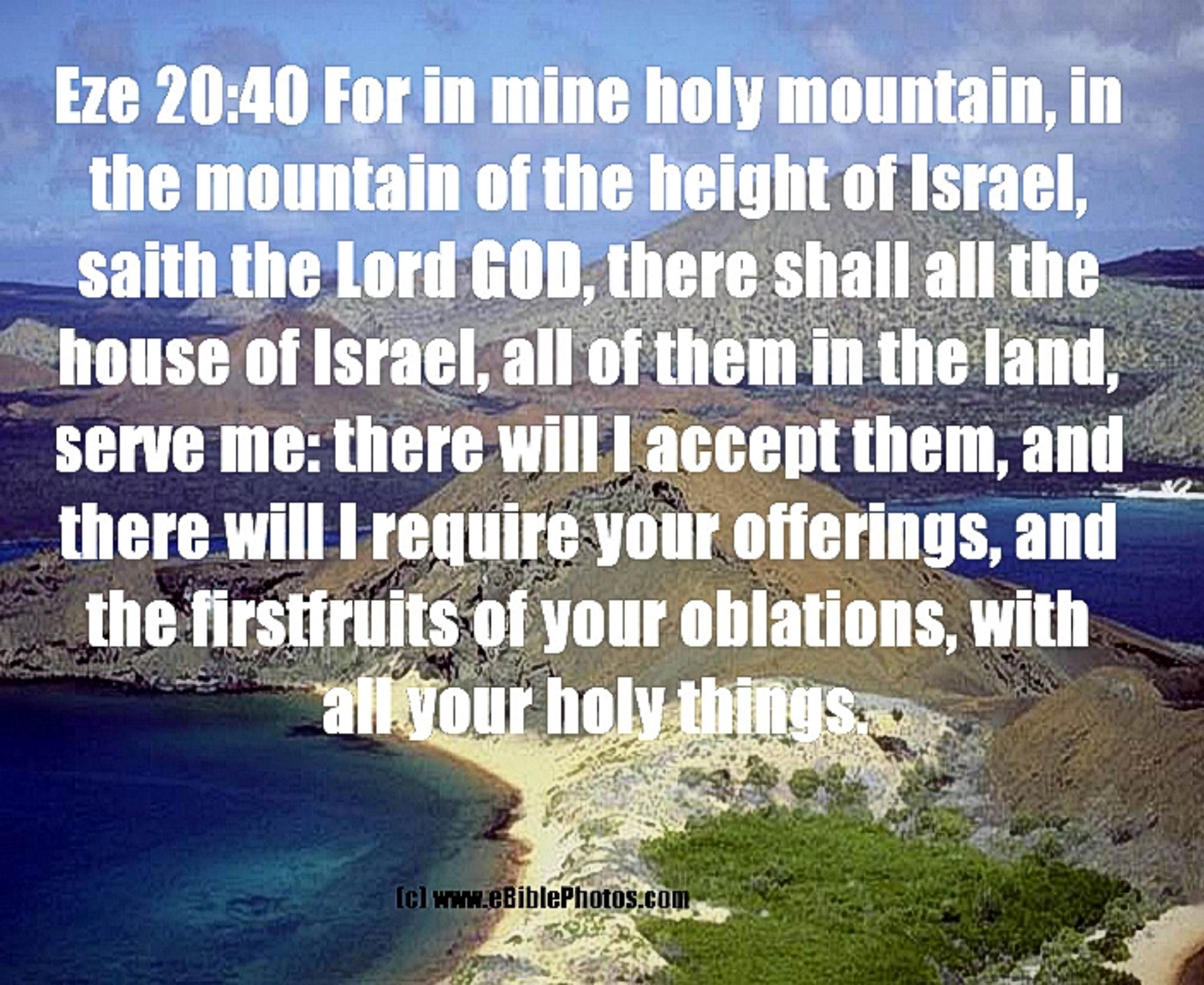

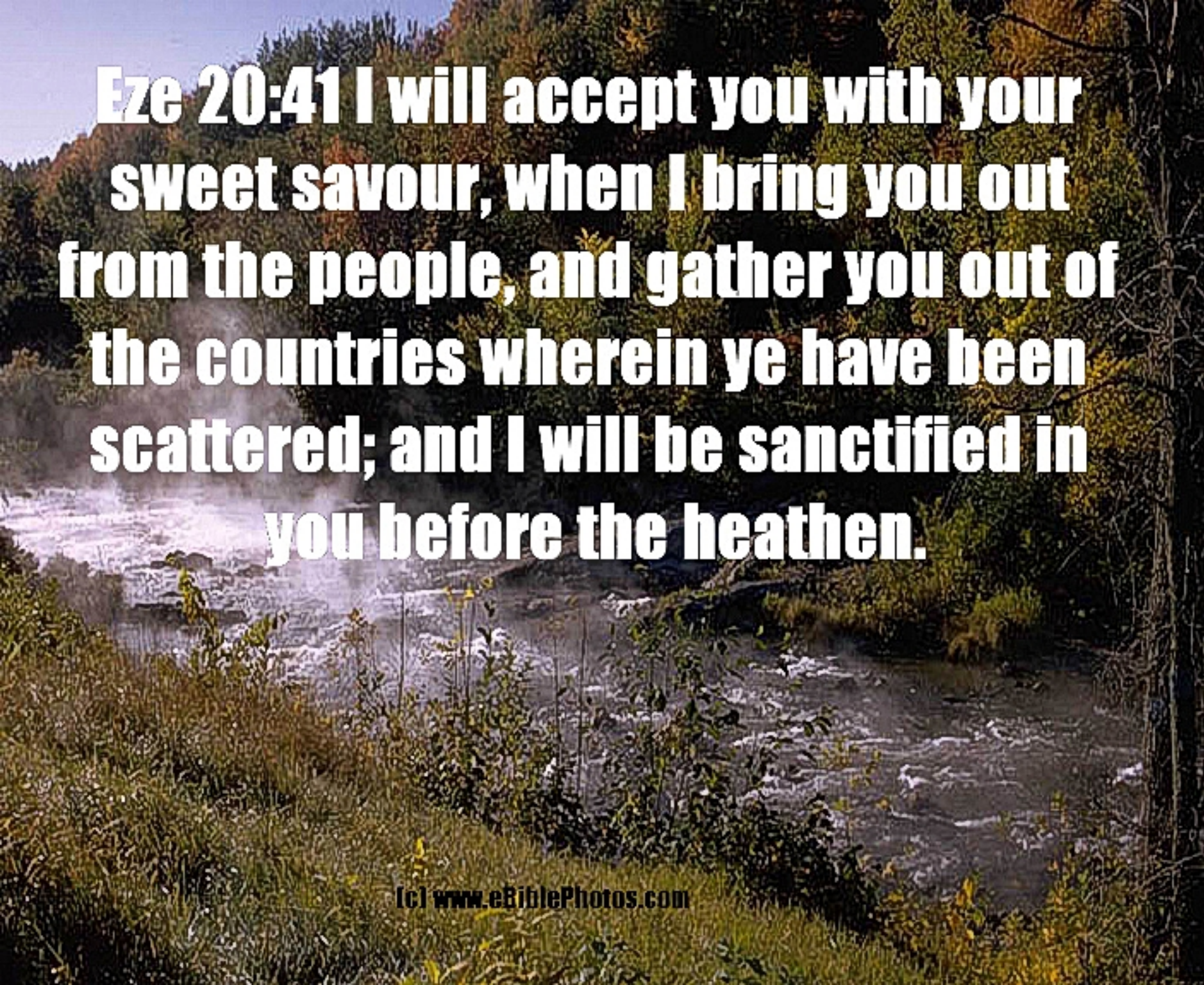

all your holy things.**



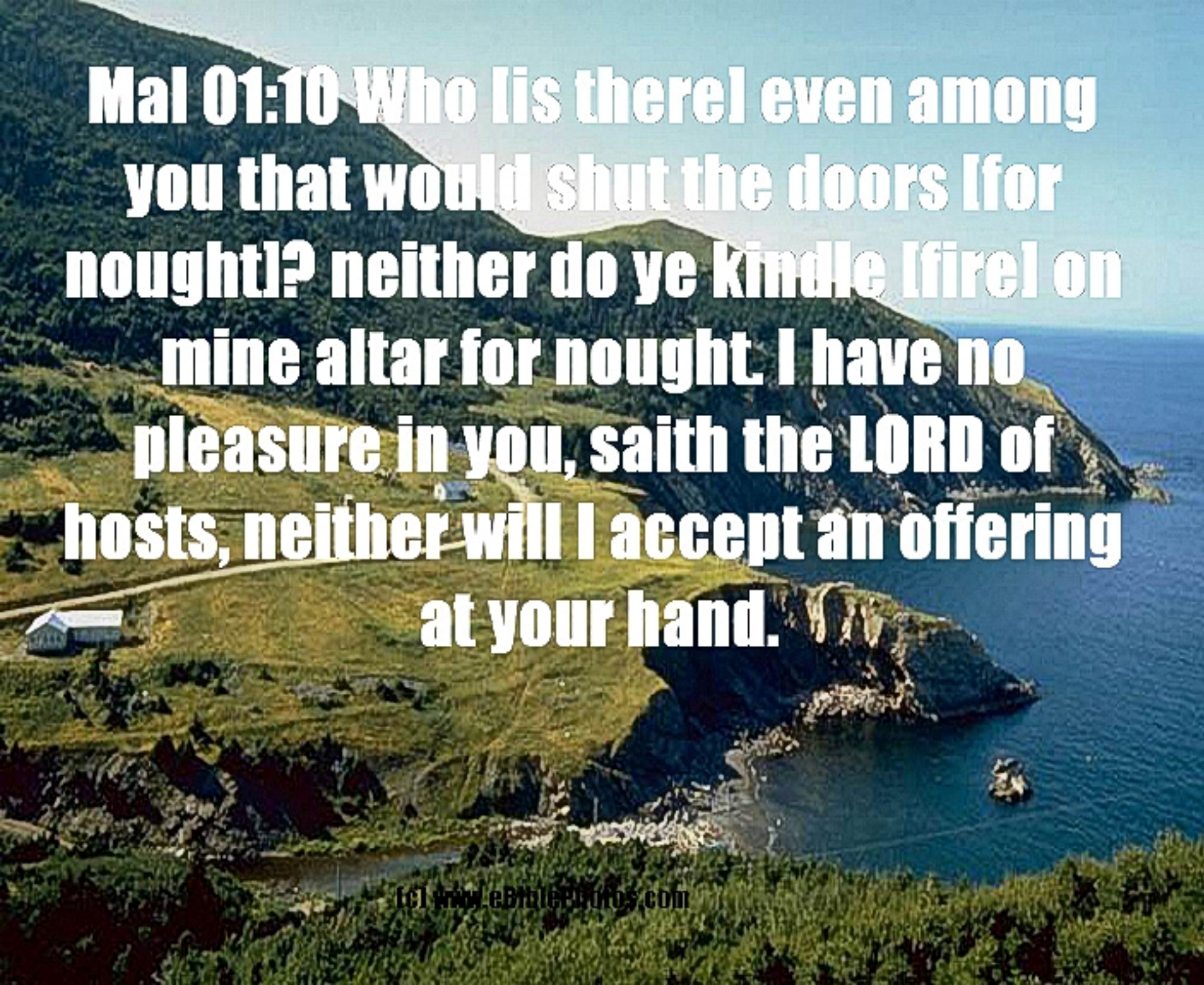
**Eze 20:41 I will accept you with your

you before the heathen.**



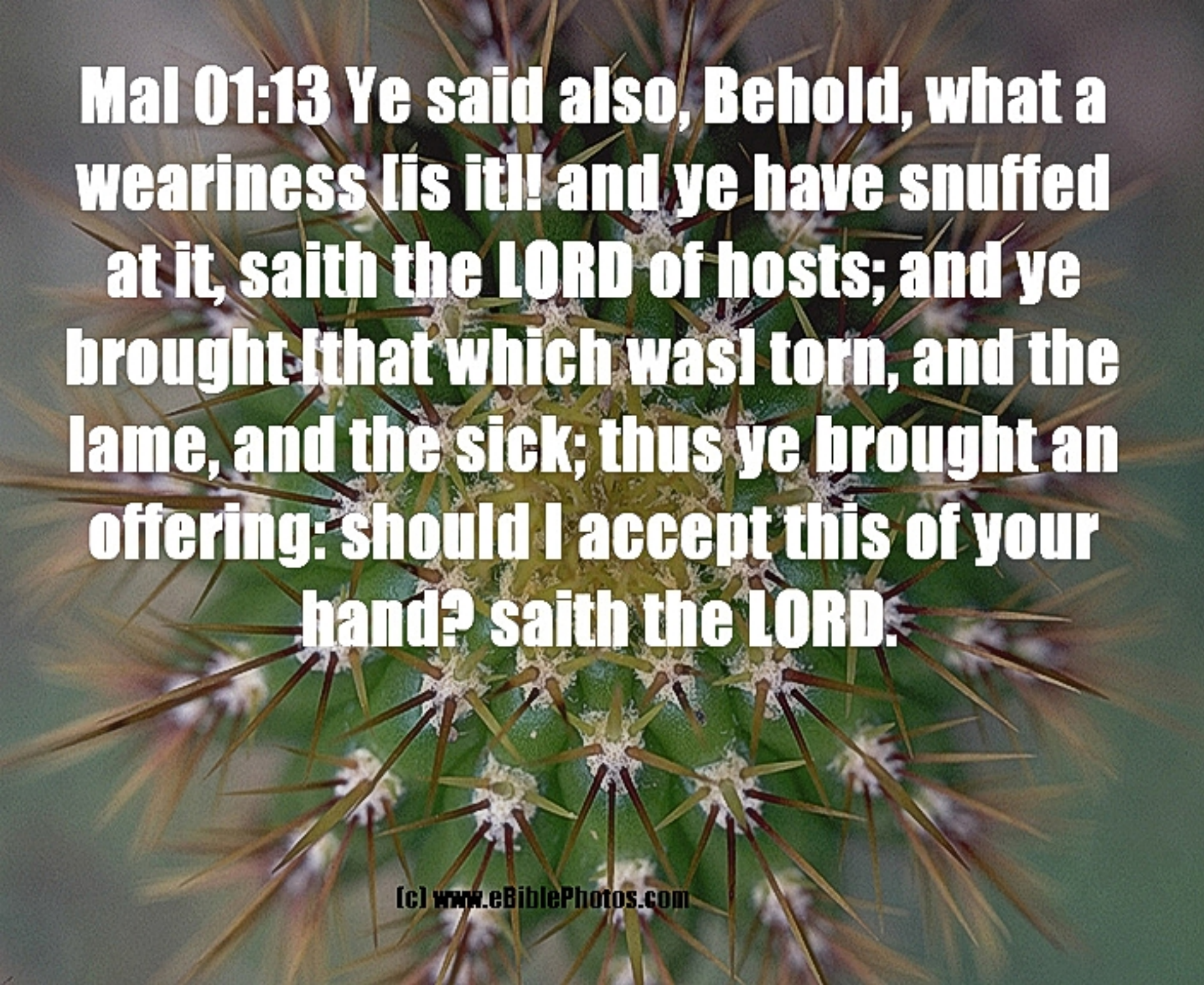
