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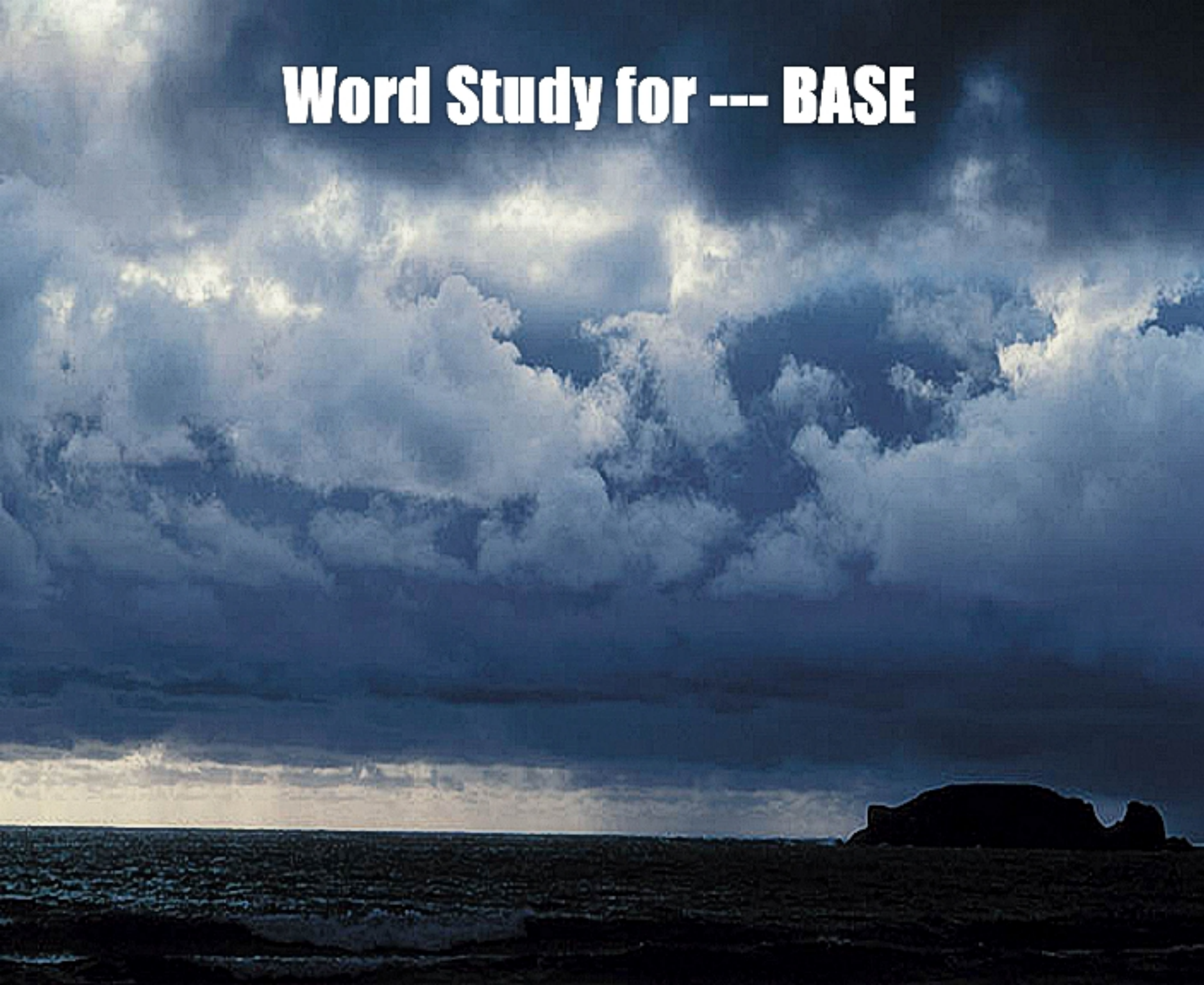
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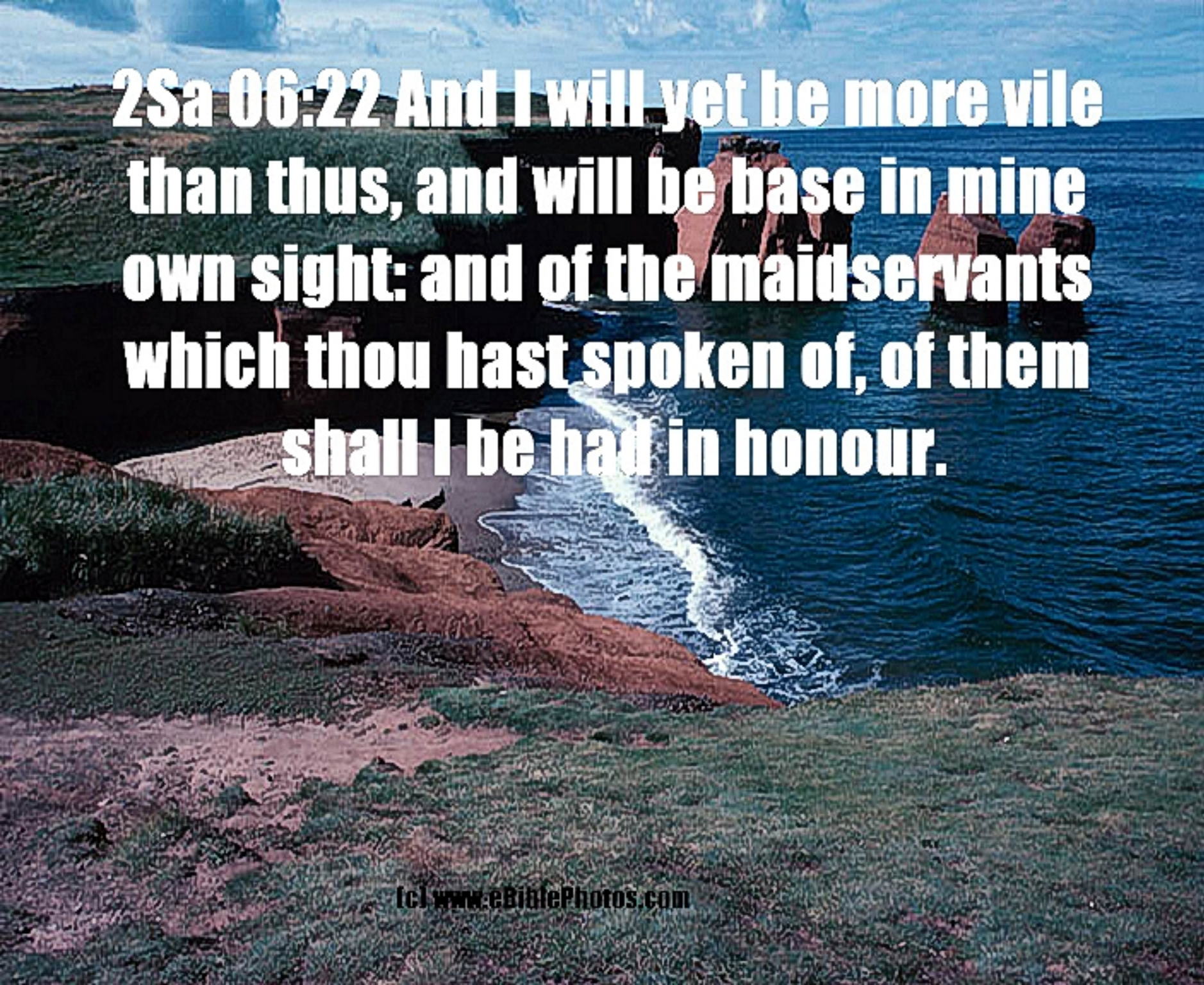

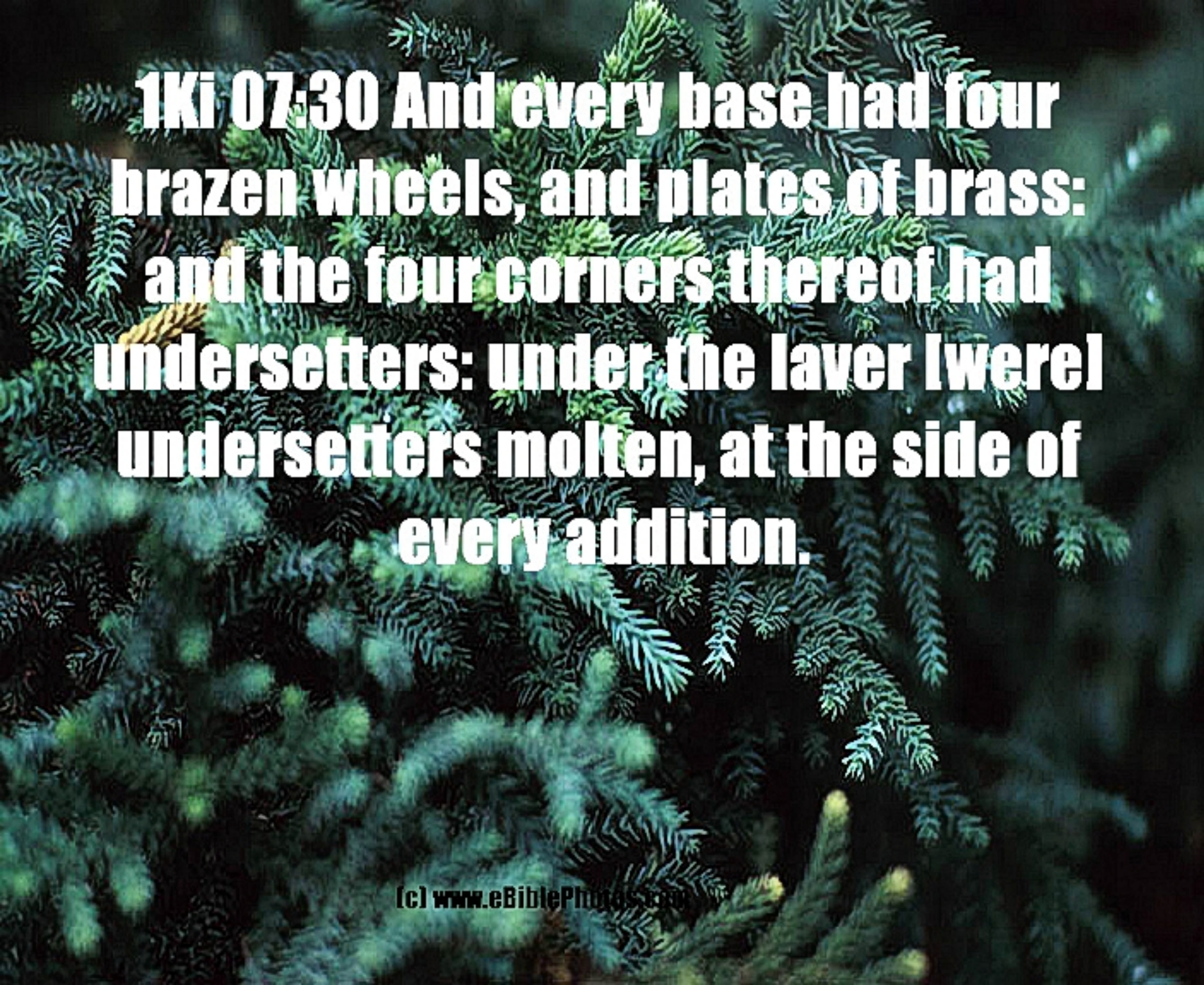

every addition.**

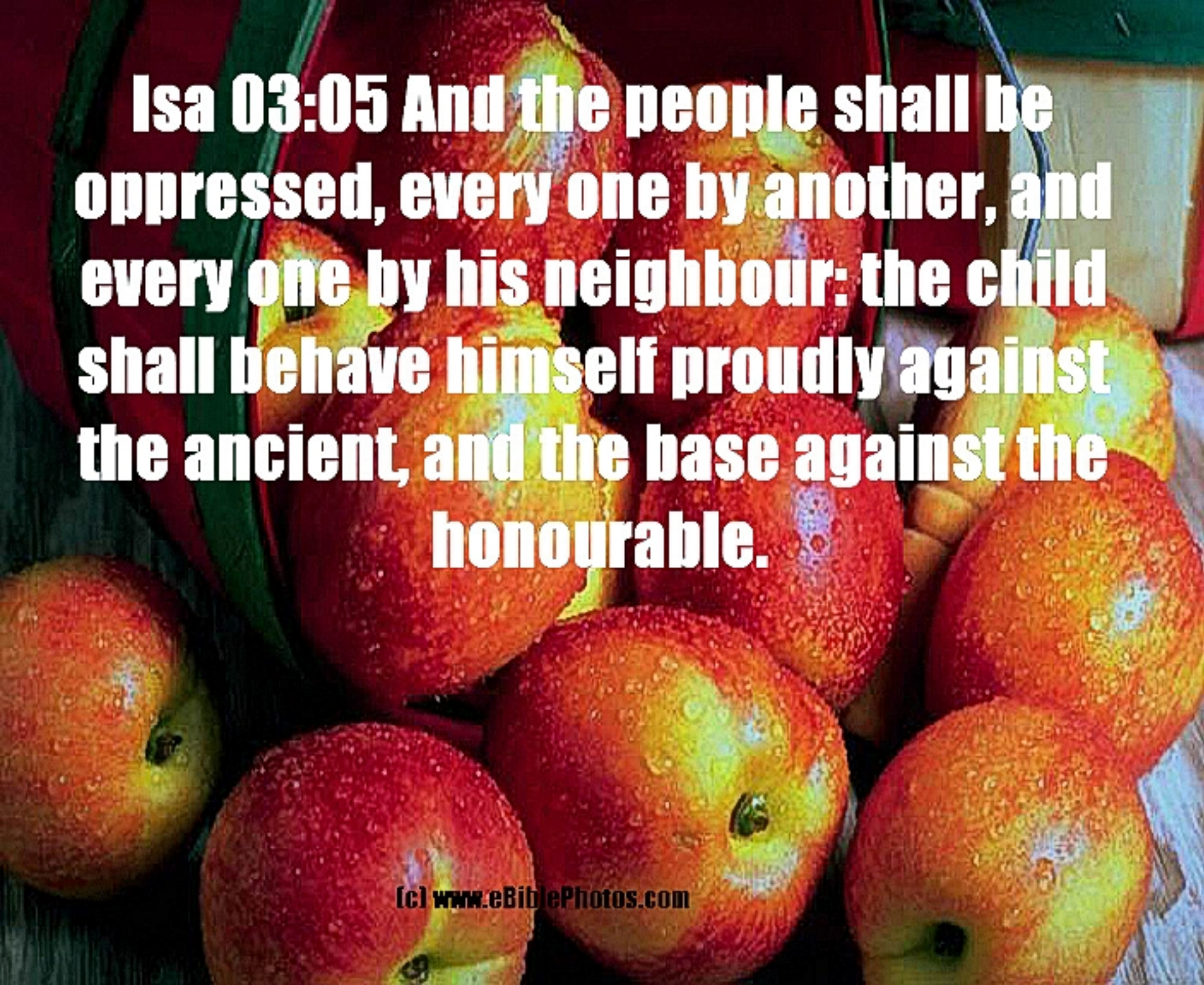
**1Ki 07:31 And the mouth of it within the

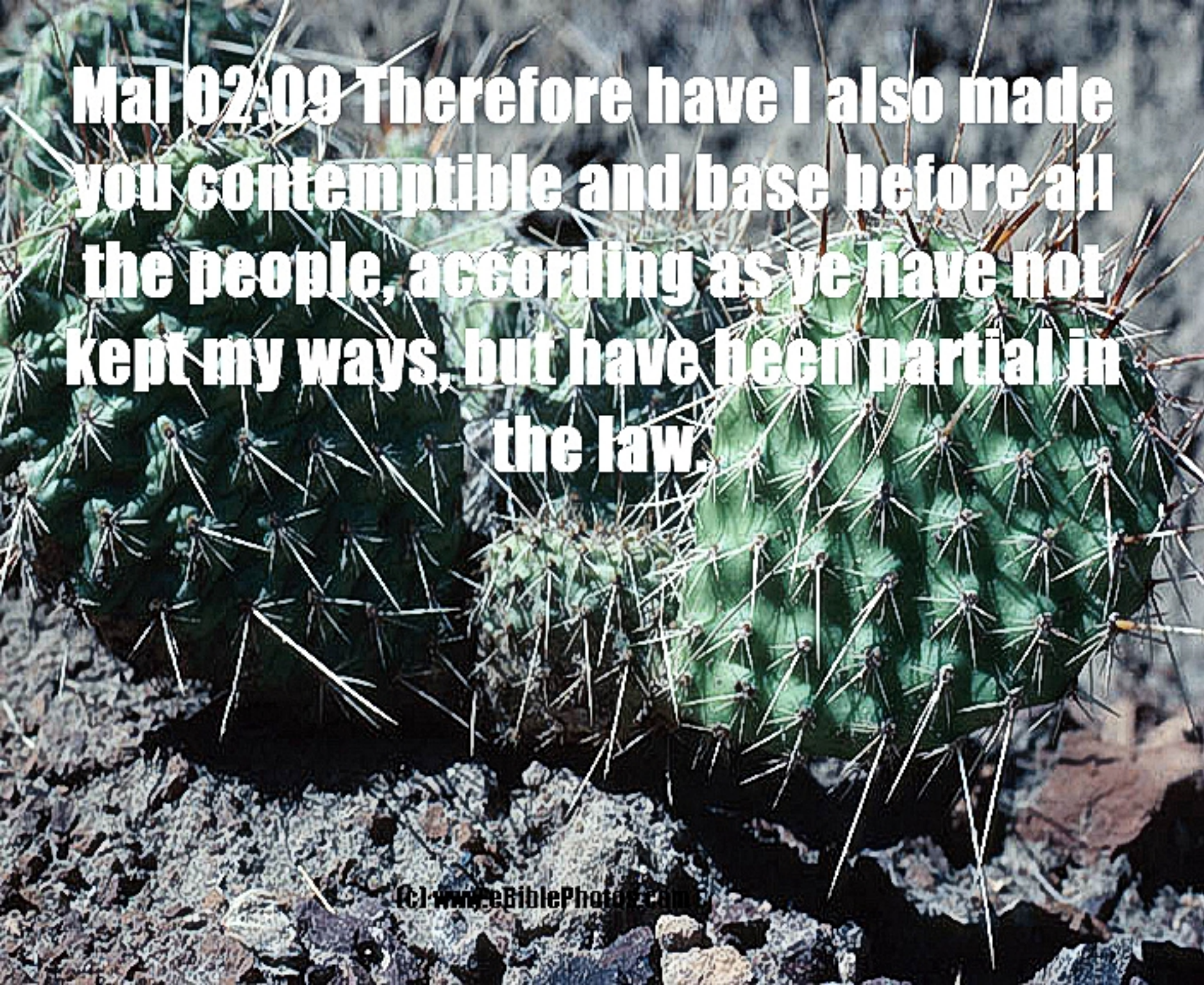

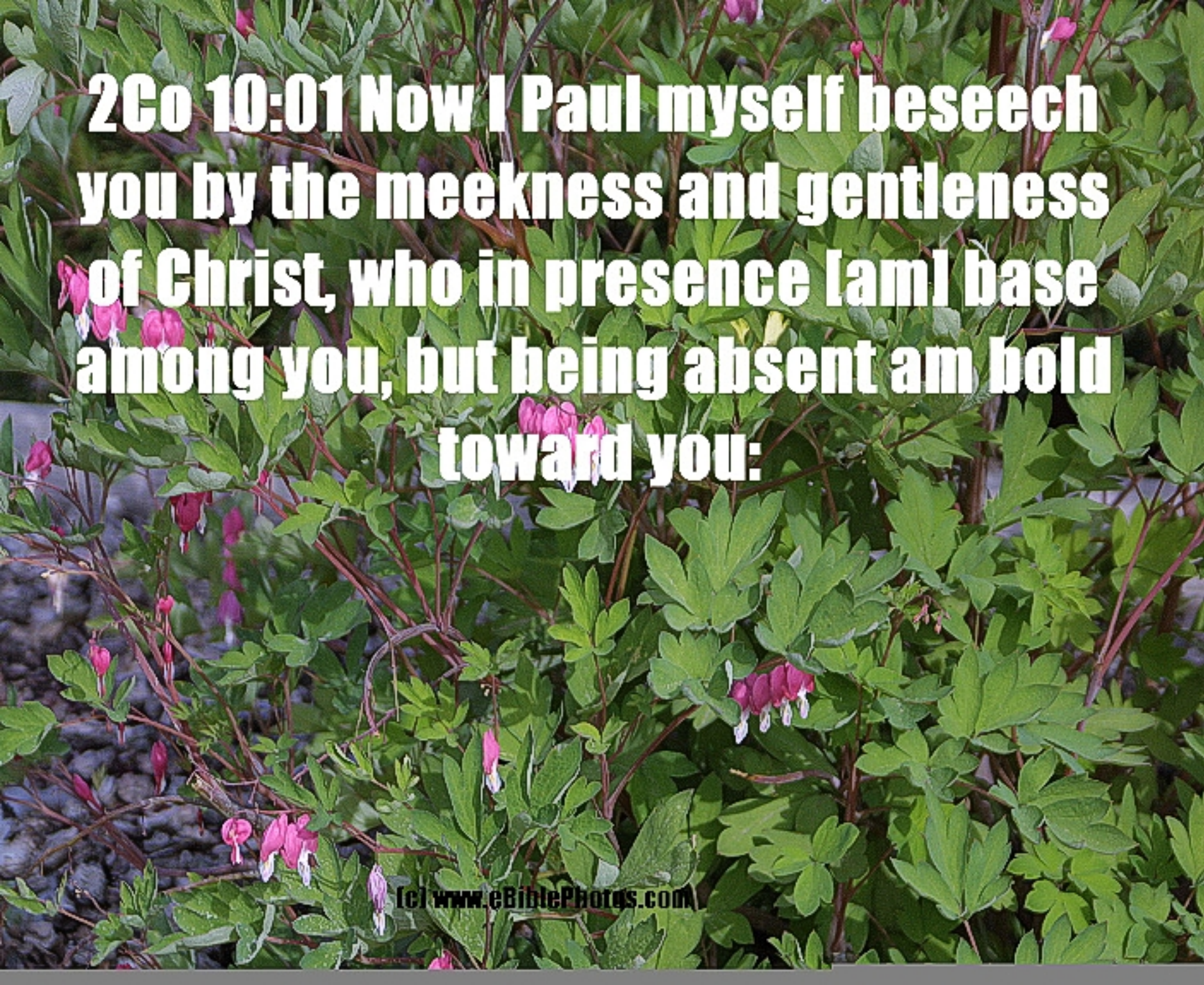
