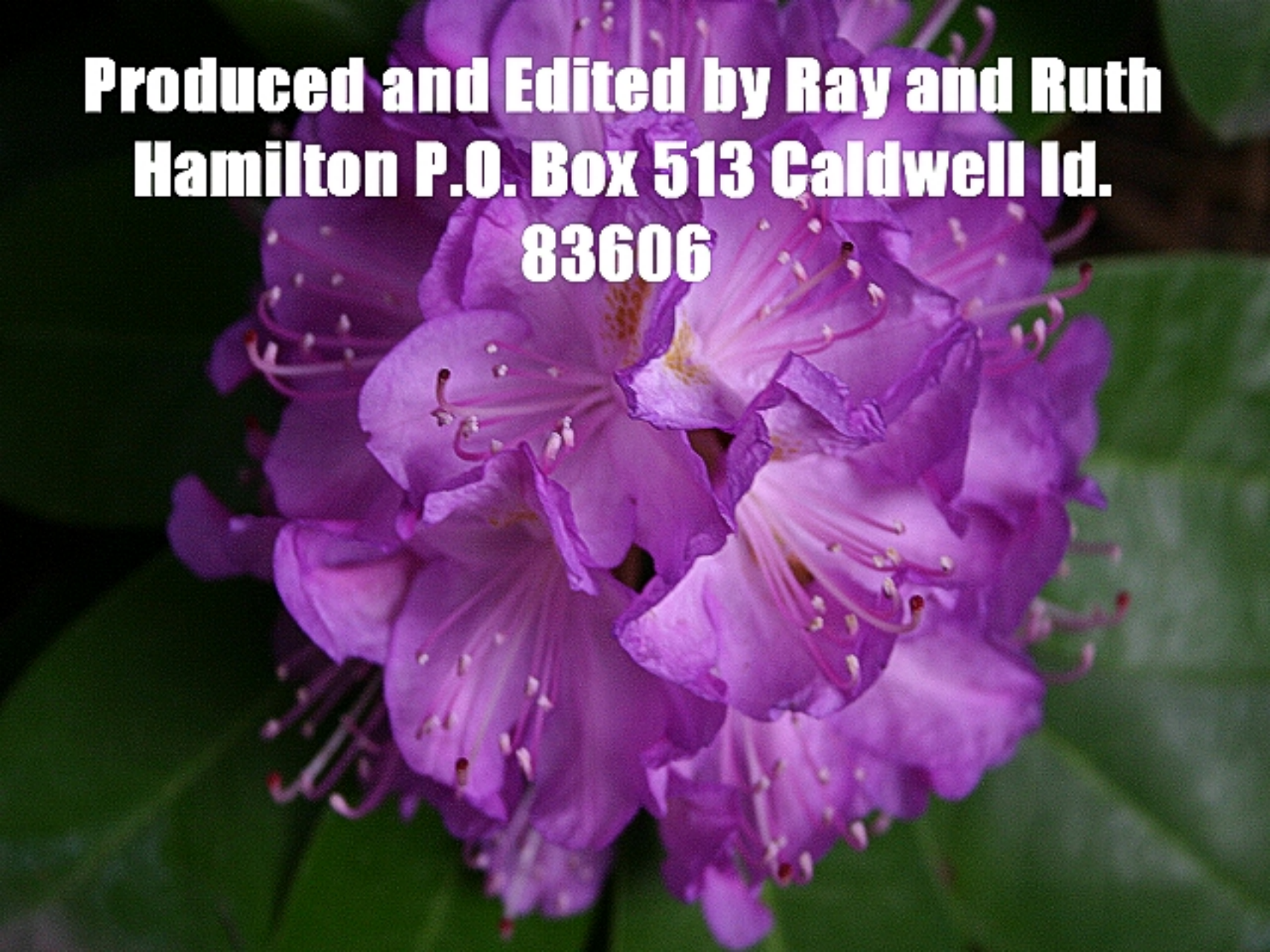


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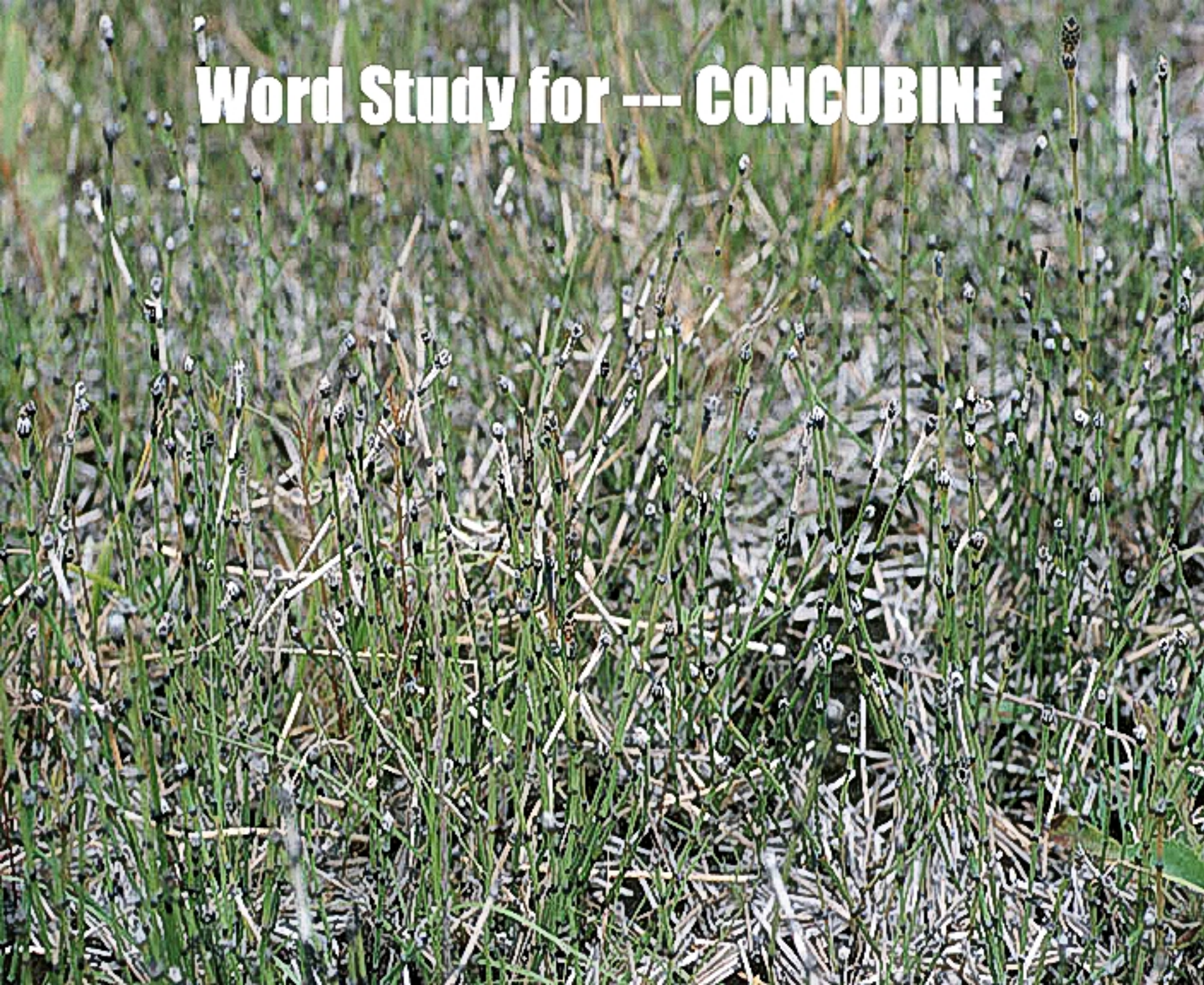

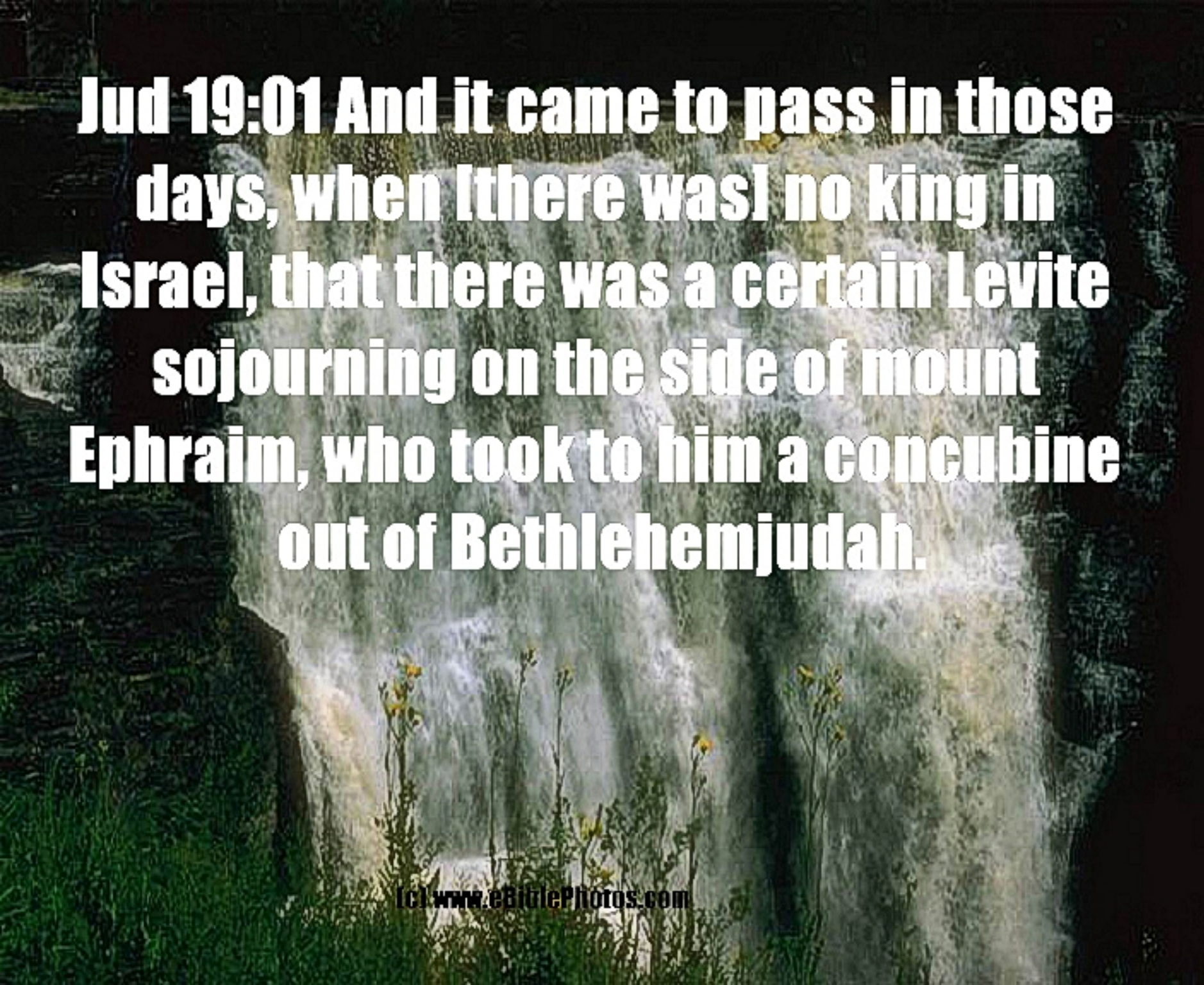
**Gen 22:24 And his concubine, whose

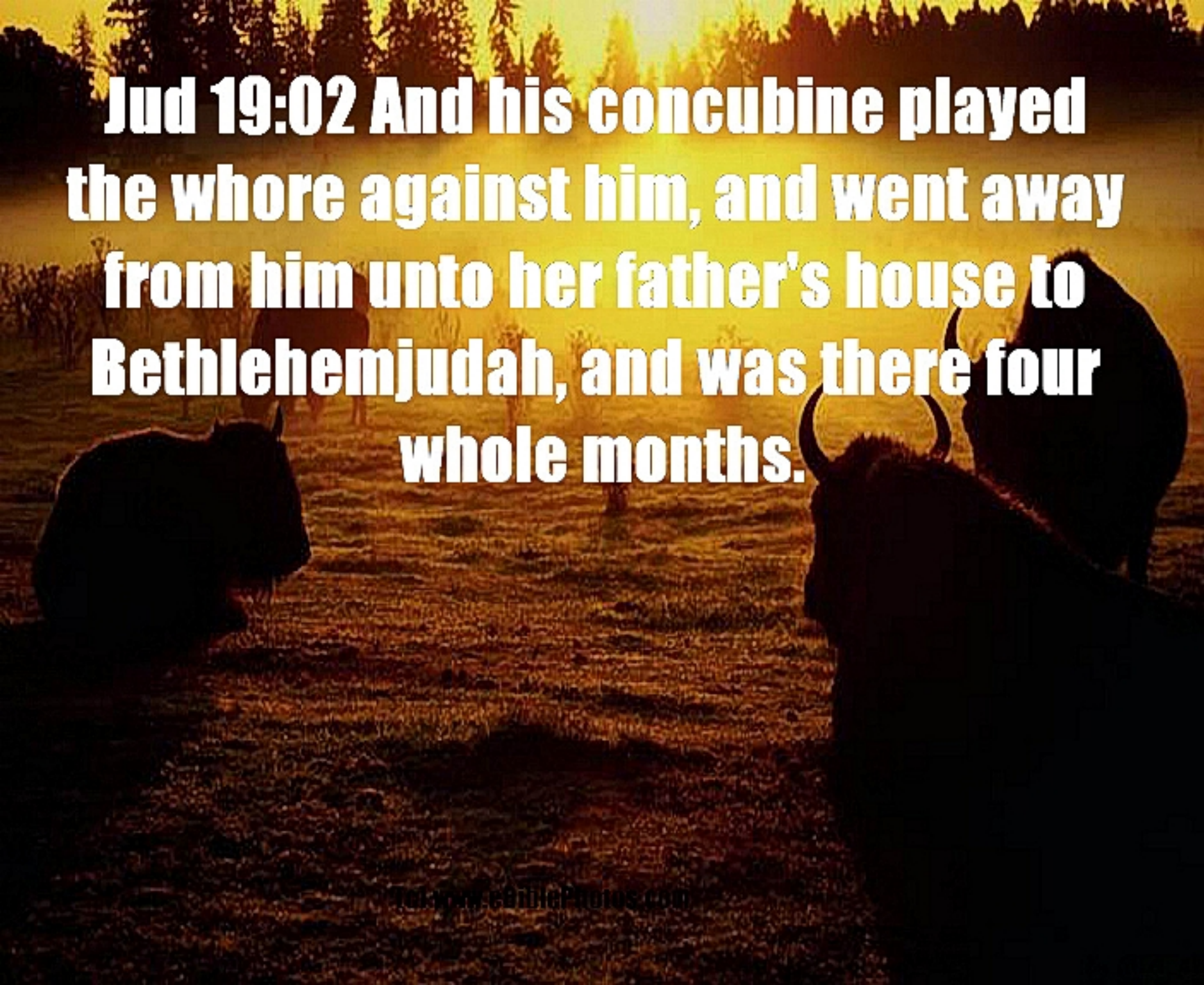


**Gen 36:12 And Timna was concubine to

whose name he called Abimelech.**



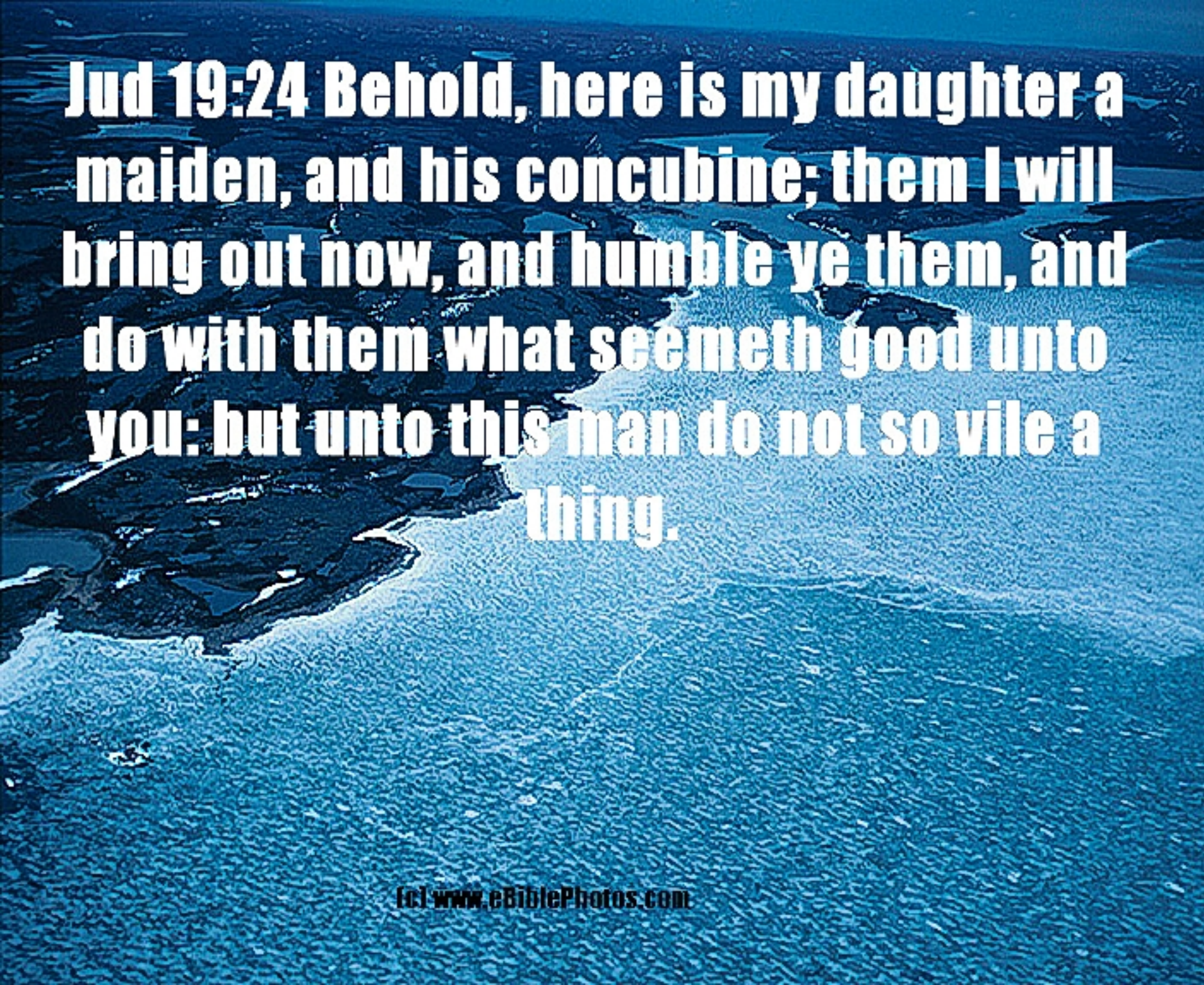

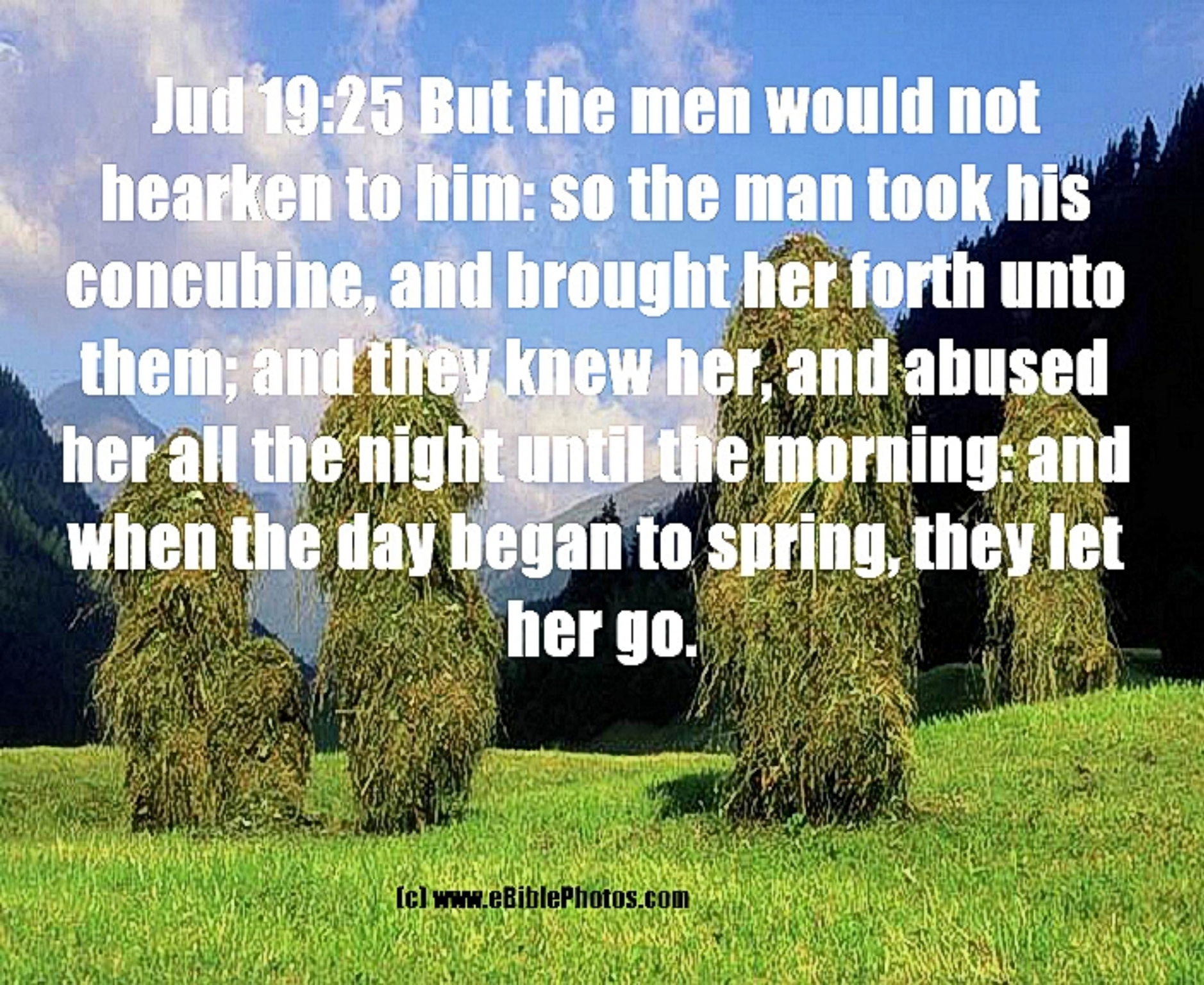
**Jud 19:02 And his concubine played

with him.**

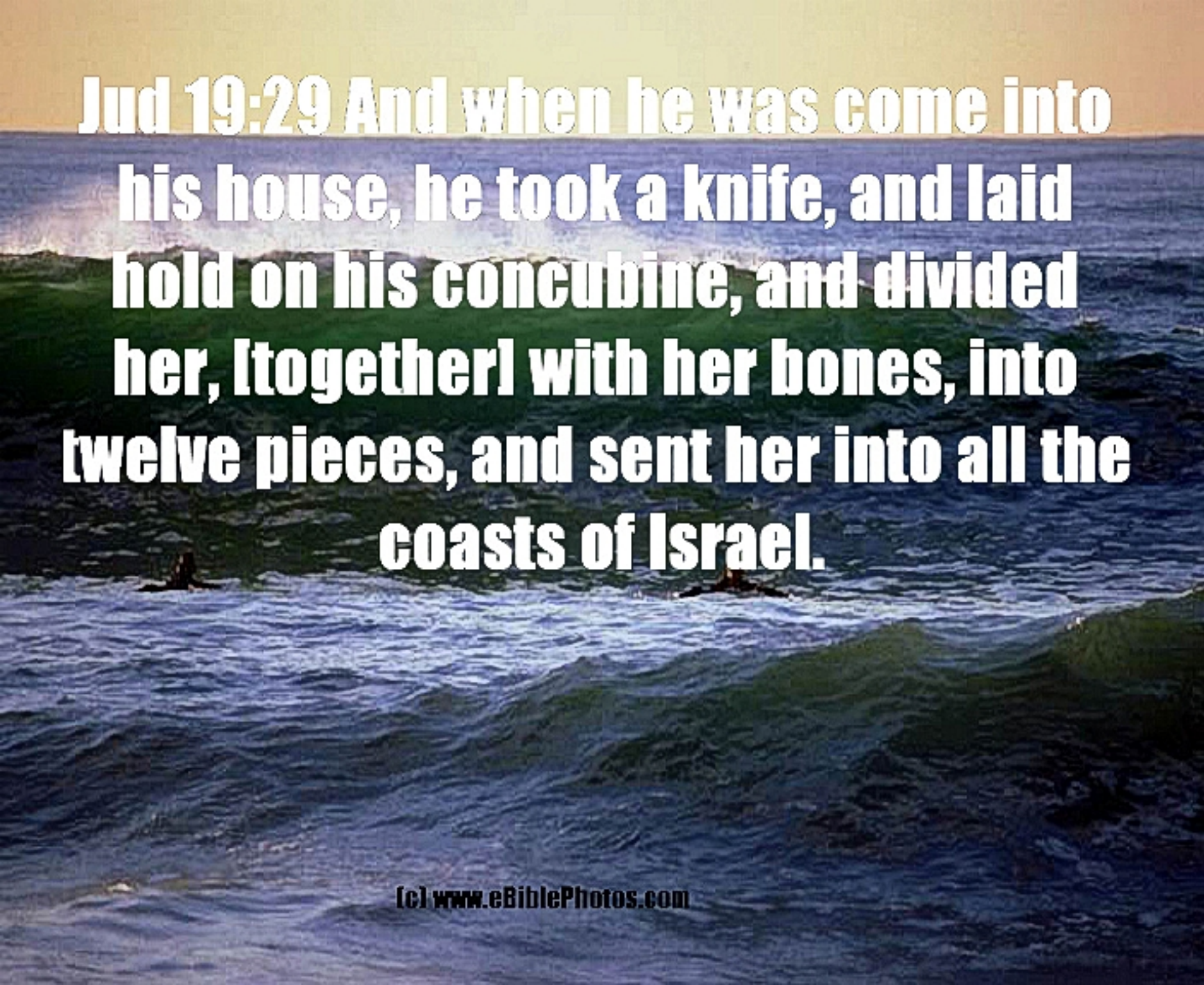

thing.**

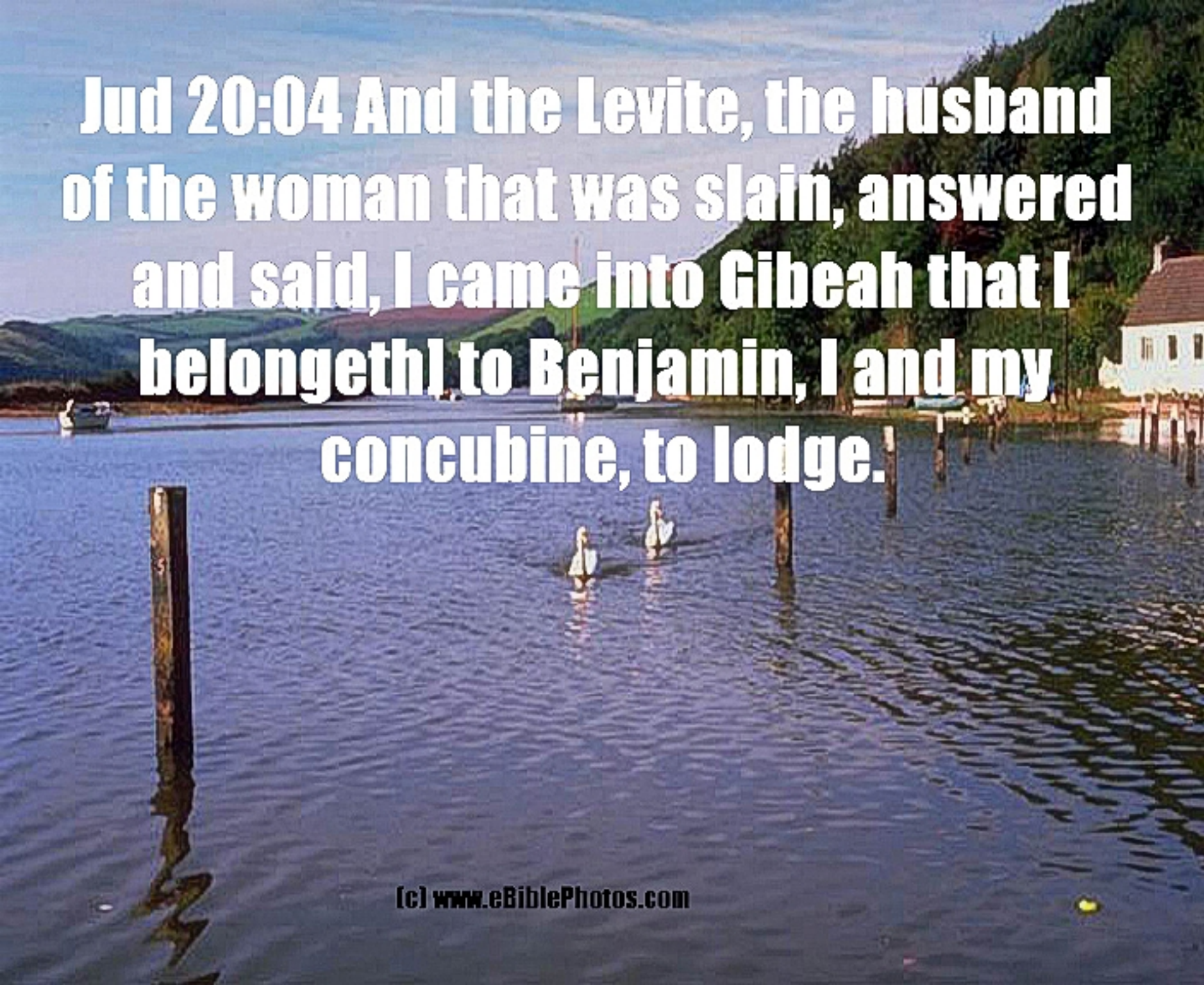

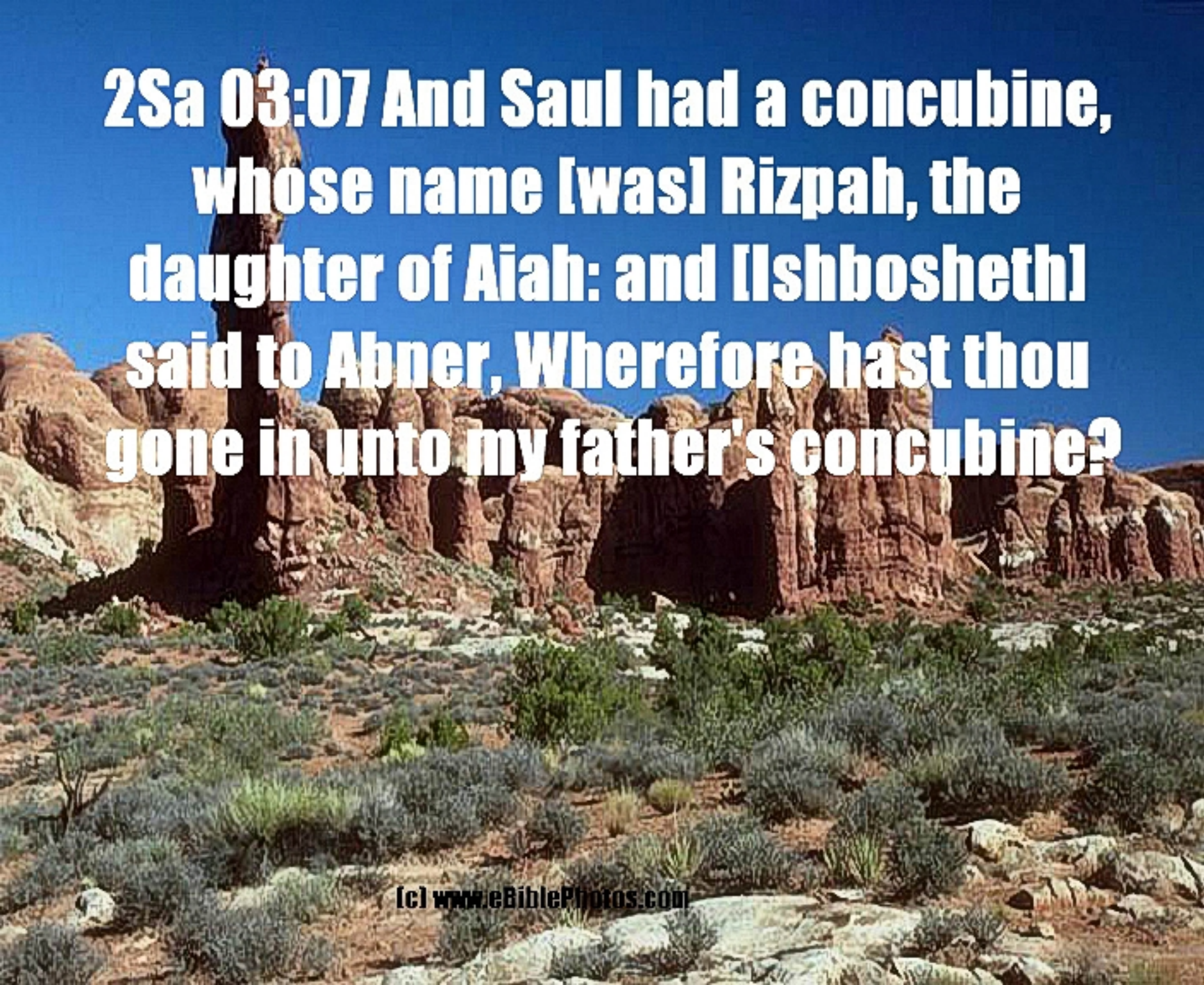
**Jud 19:29 And when he was come into

concubine, to lodge.**

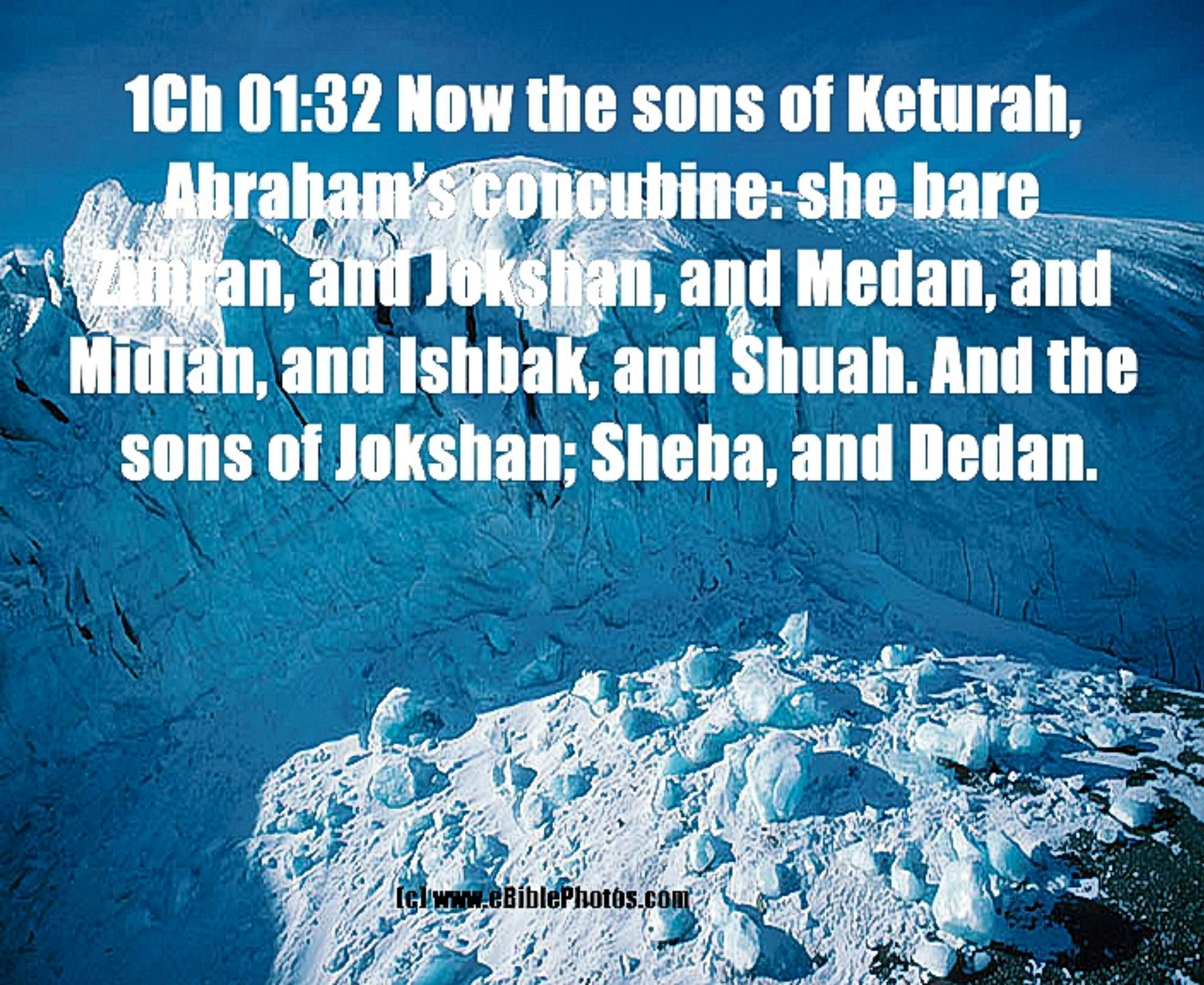
**Jud 20:05 And the men of Gibeah rose
