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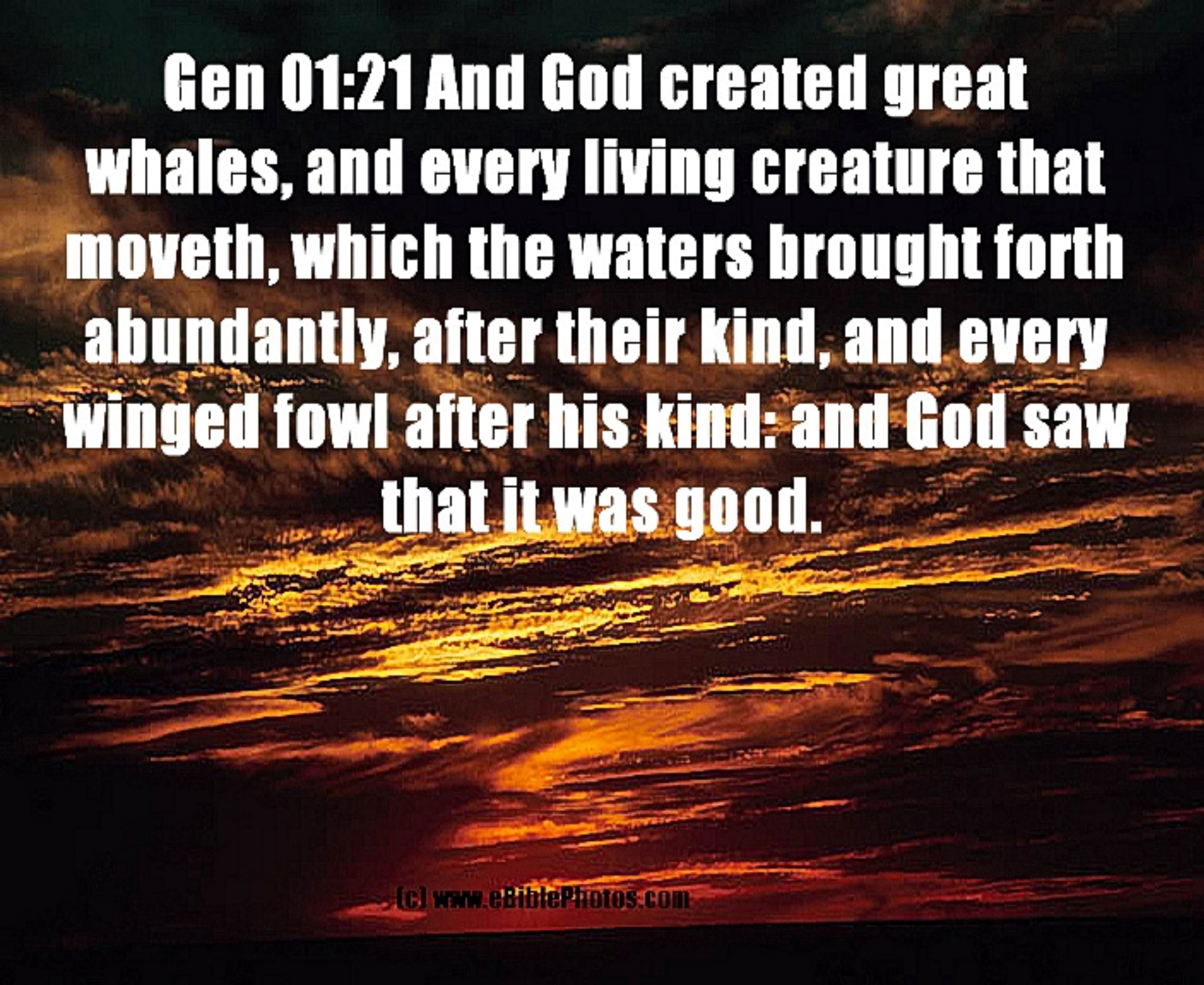

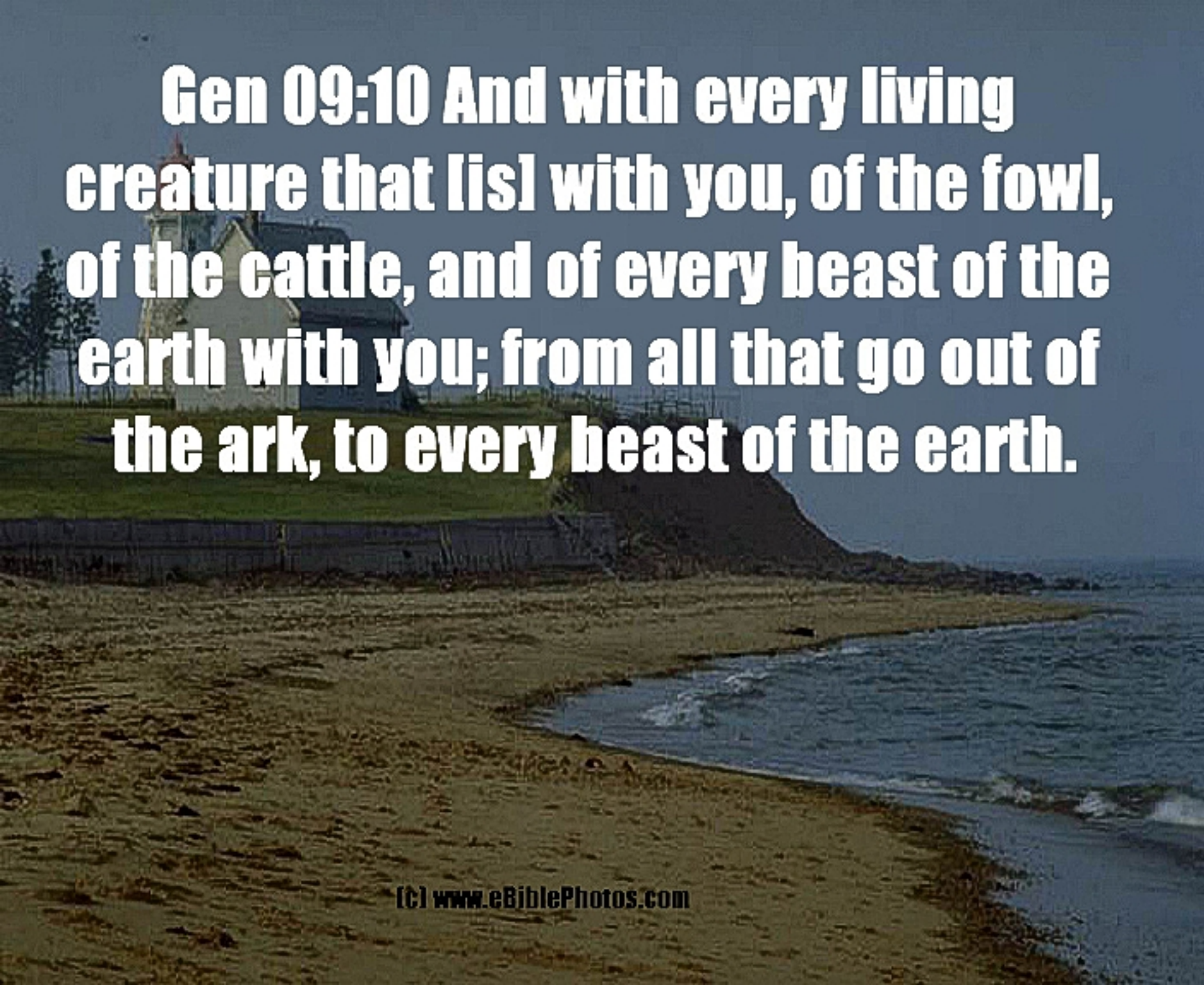
**Gen 01:20 And God said, Let the waters

was so.**

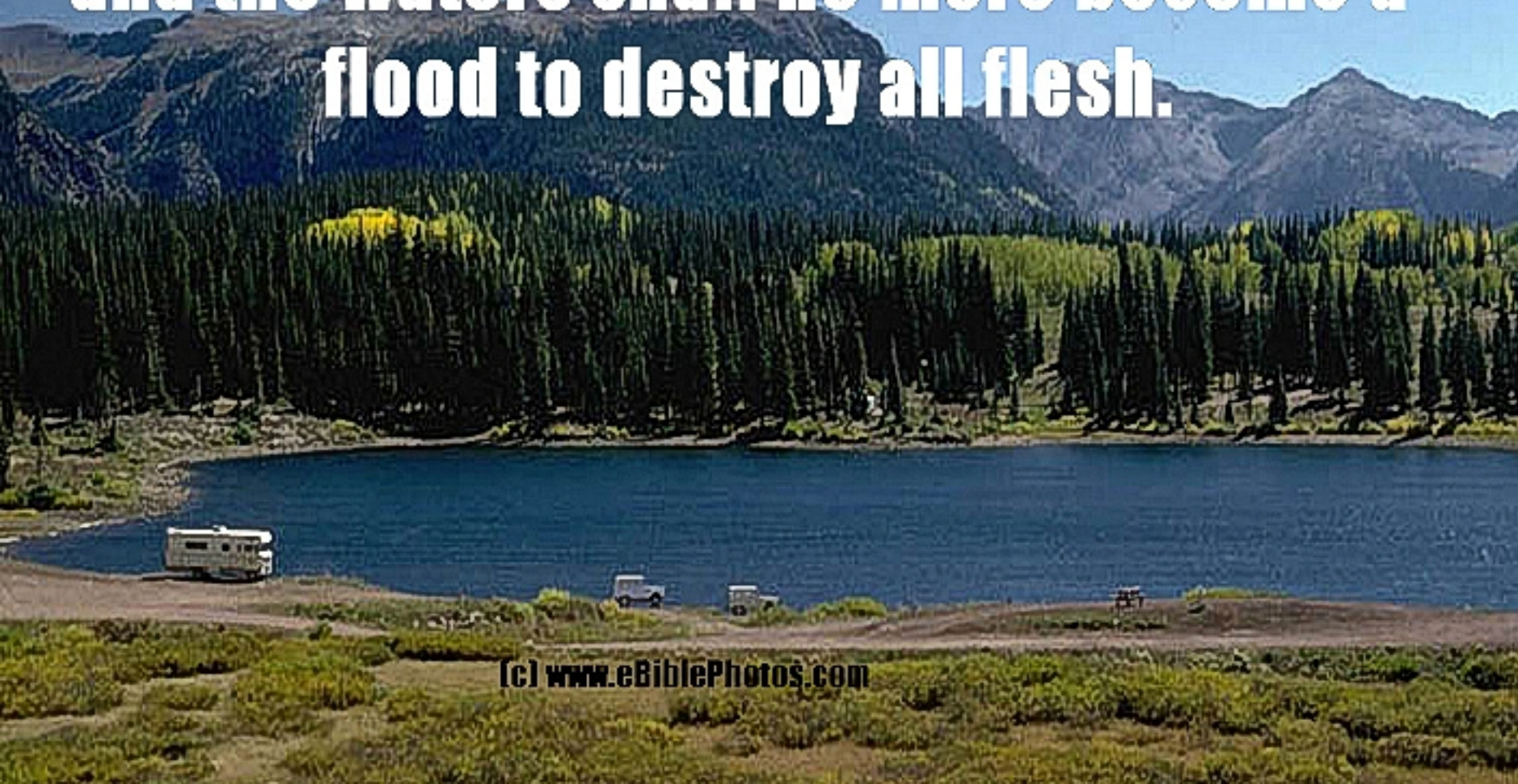

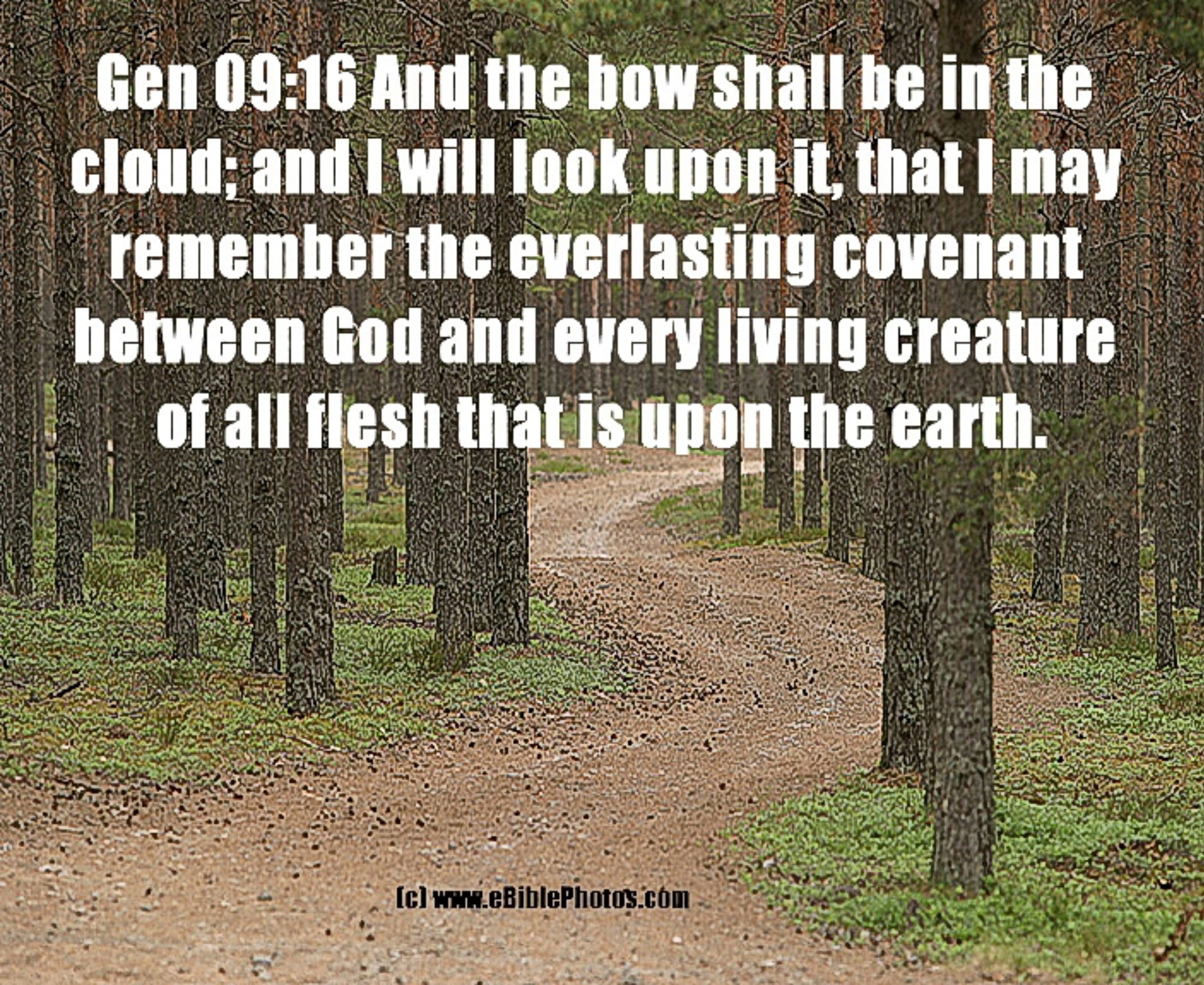

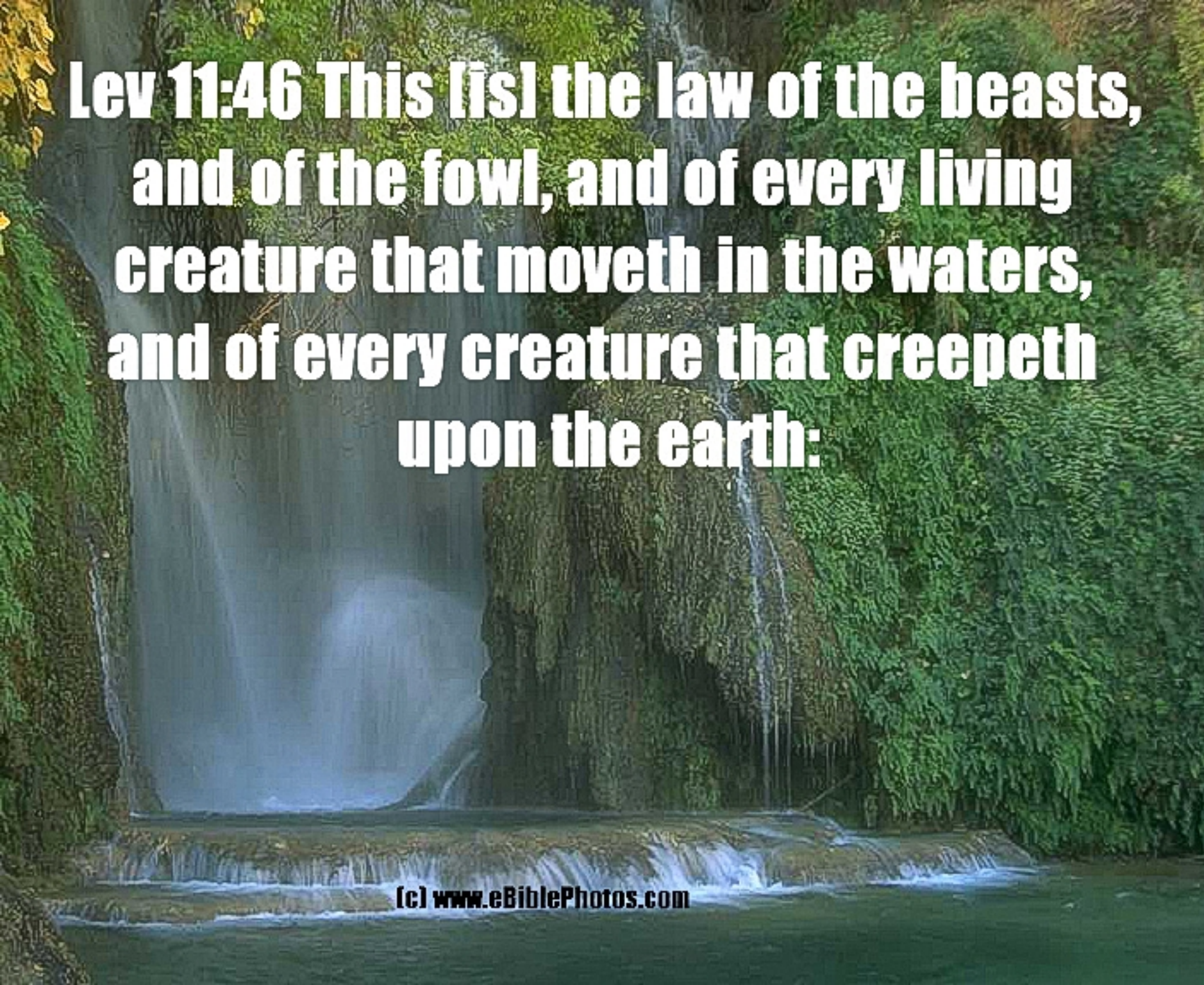
Gen 09:12 And God said, This is the token of the covenant which I make between me and you and every living creature that is with you, for perpetual generations:

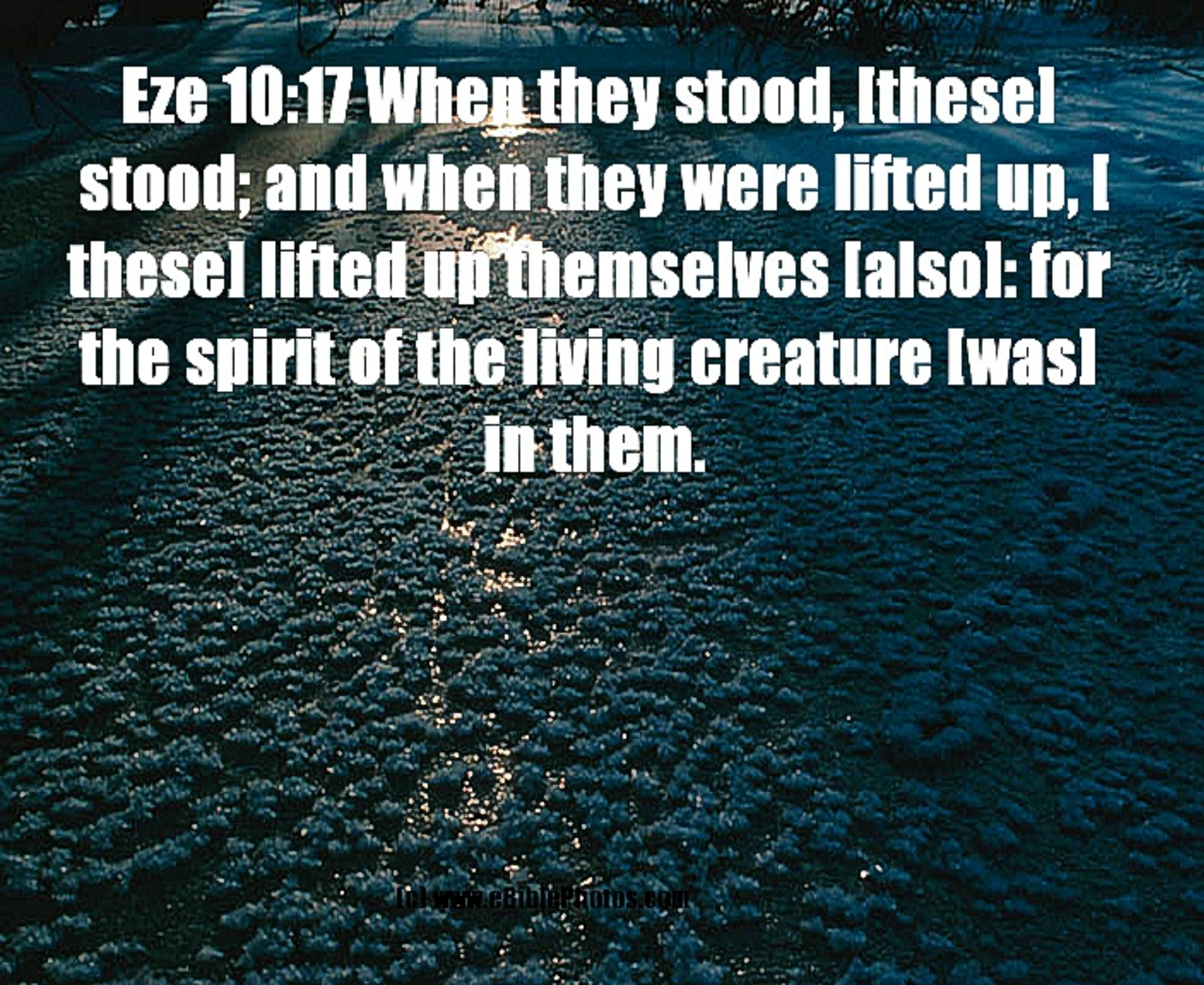
**Lev 11:46 This [is] the law of the beasts,

their heads above.**

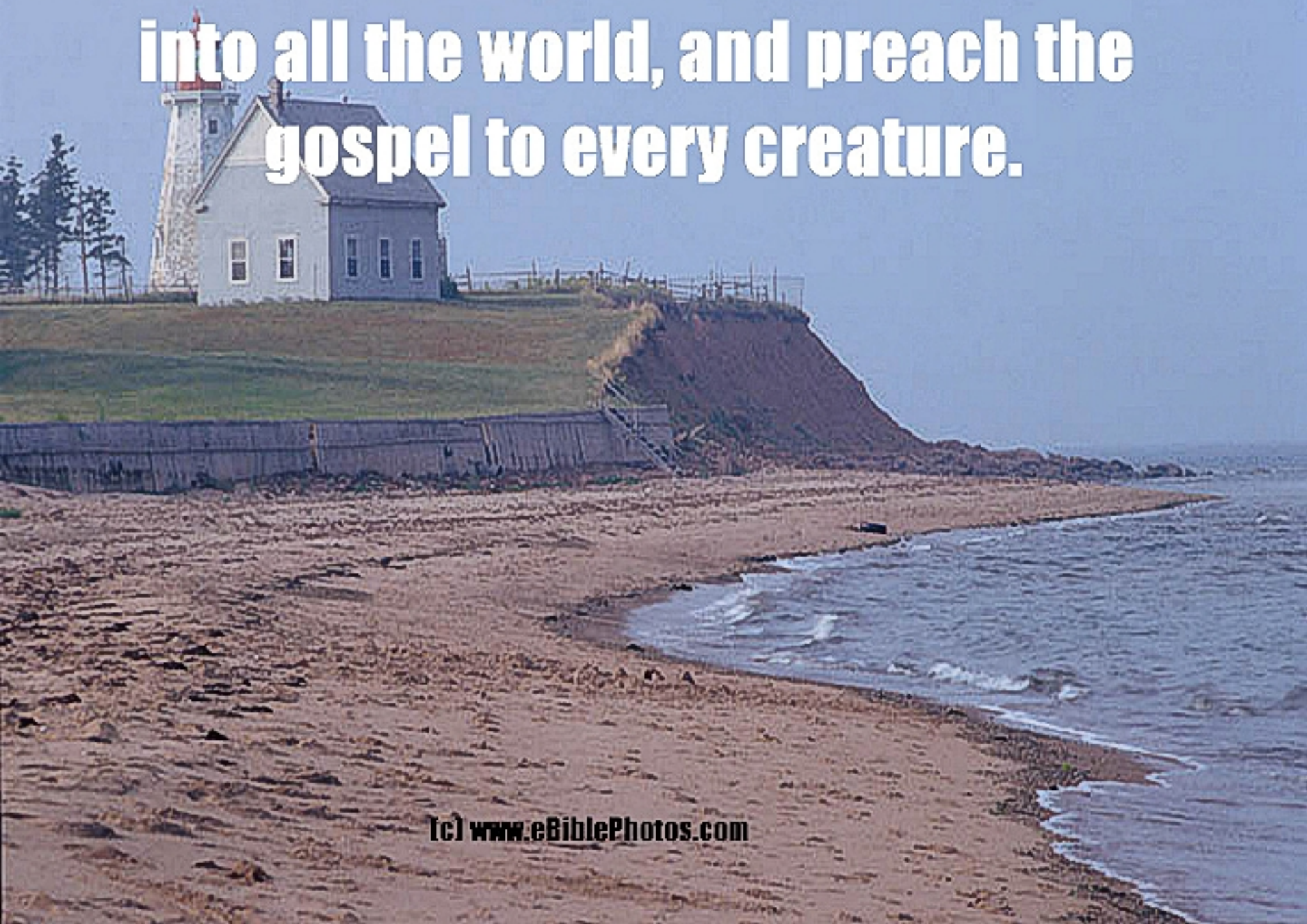
**Eze 10:15 And the cherubims were

that I saw by the river of Chebar.**

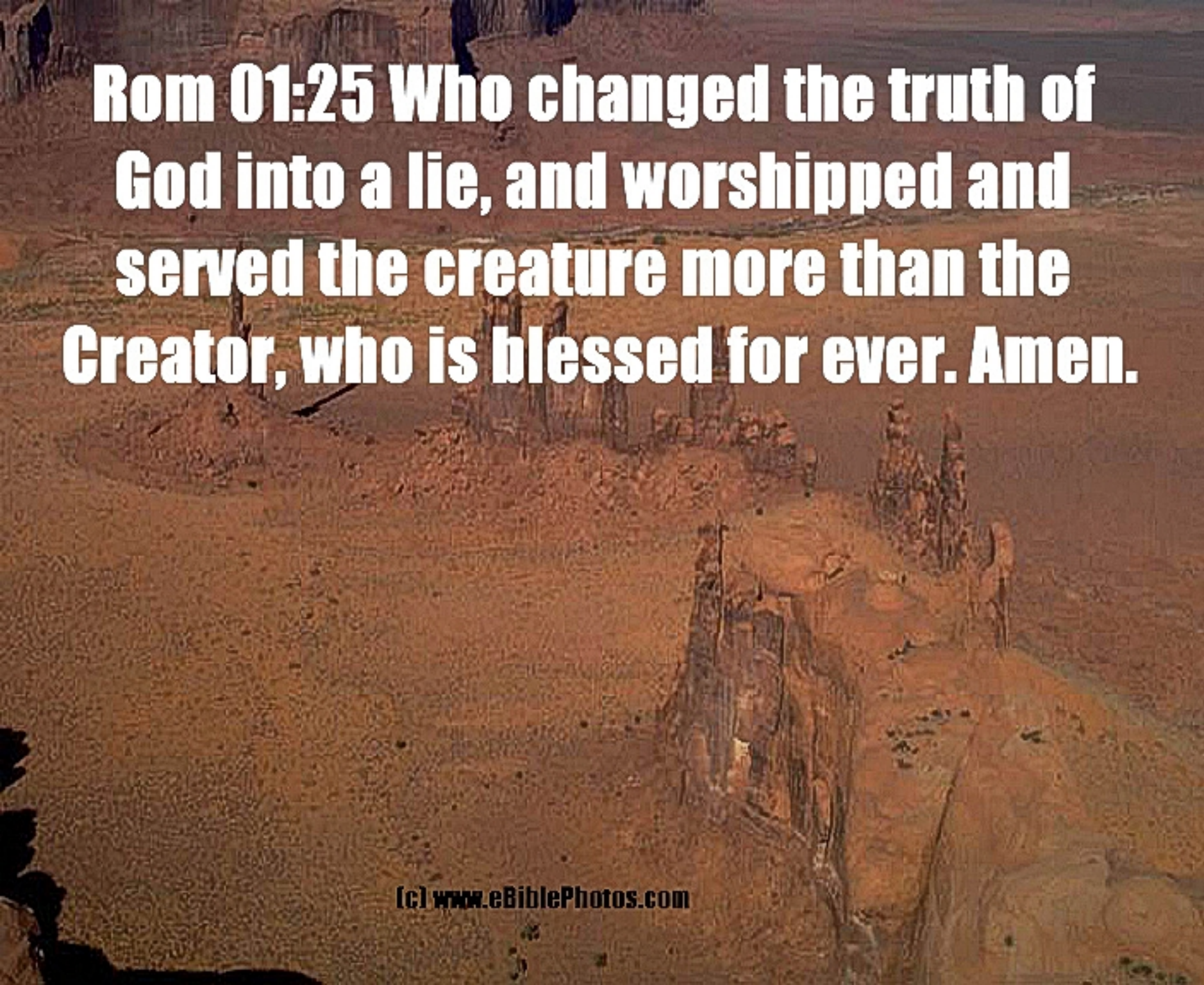


**Eze 10:17 When they stood, I these I

manifestation of the sons of God.**



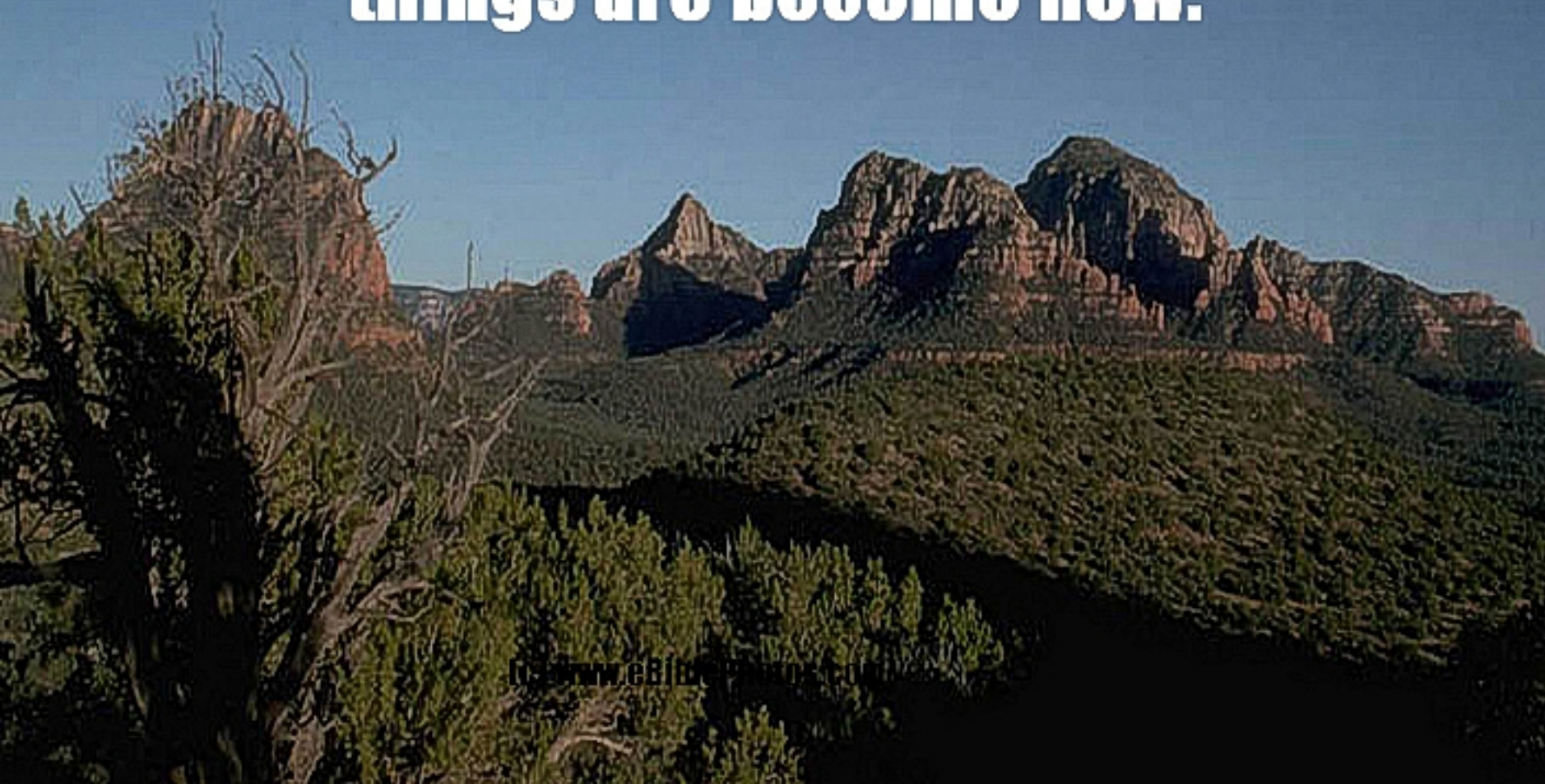
**Rom 08:20 For the creature was made

glorious liberty of the children of God.**



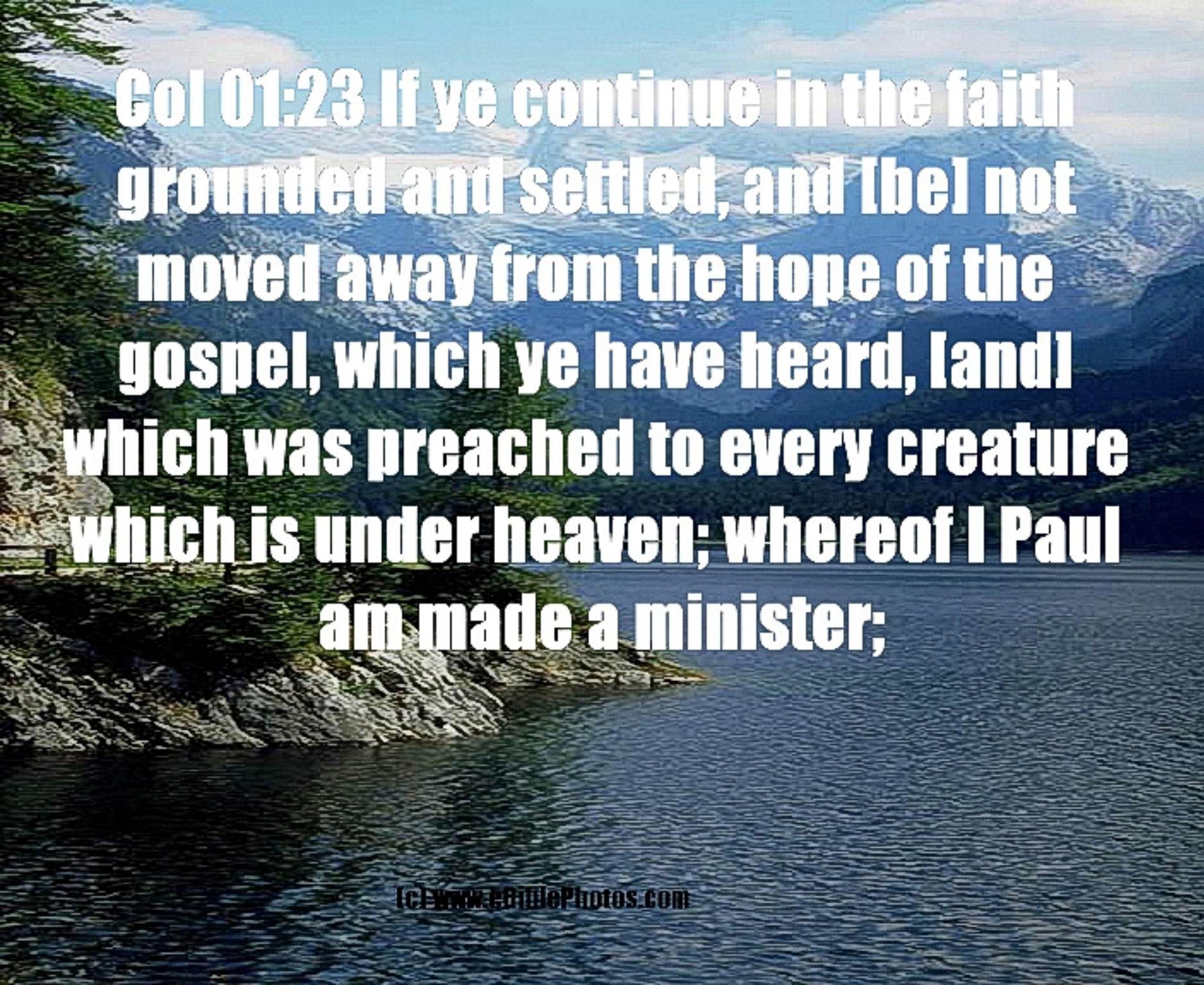
**Rom 08:39 Nor height, nor depth, nor

things are become new.**



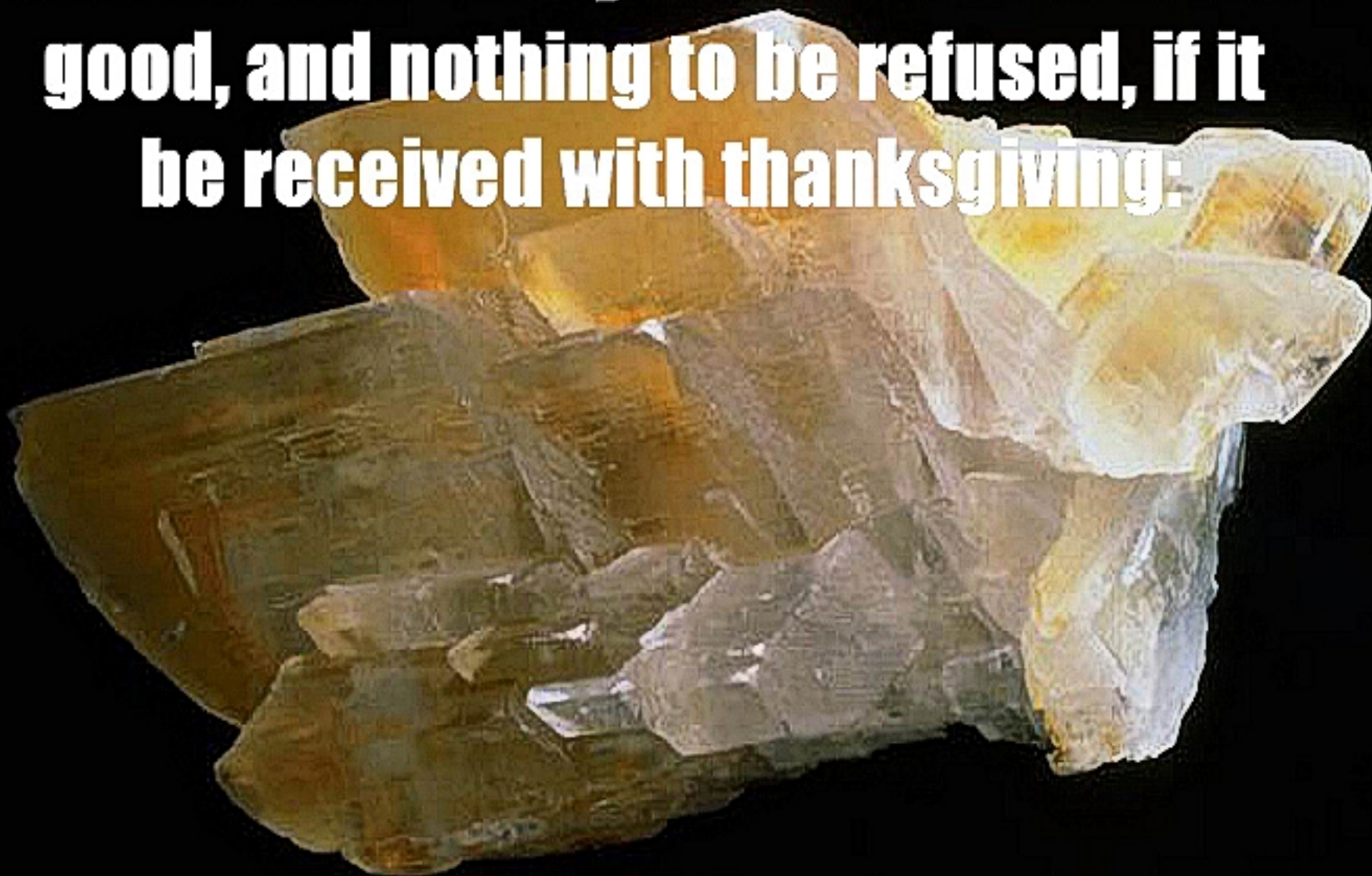
**Gal 06:15 For in Christ Jesus neither

creature:**

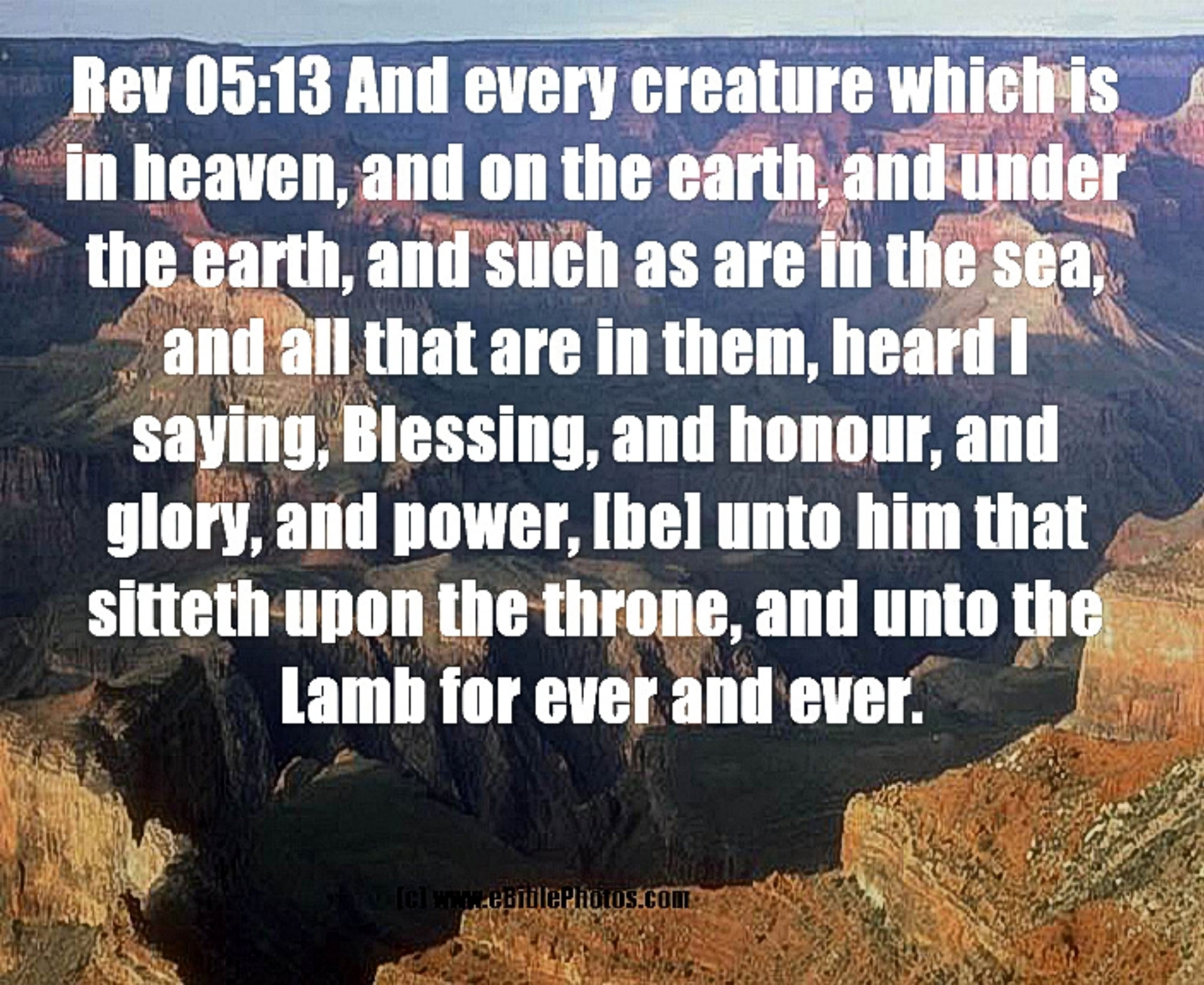


**Col 01:23 If ye continue in the faith
