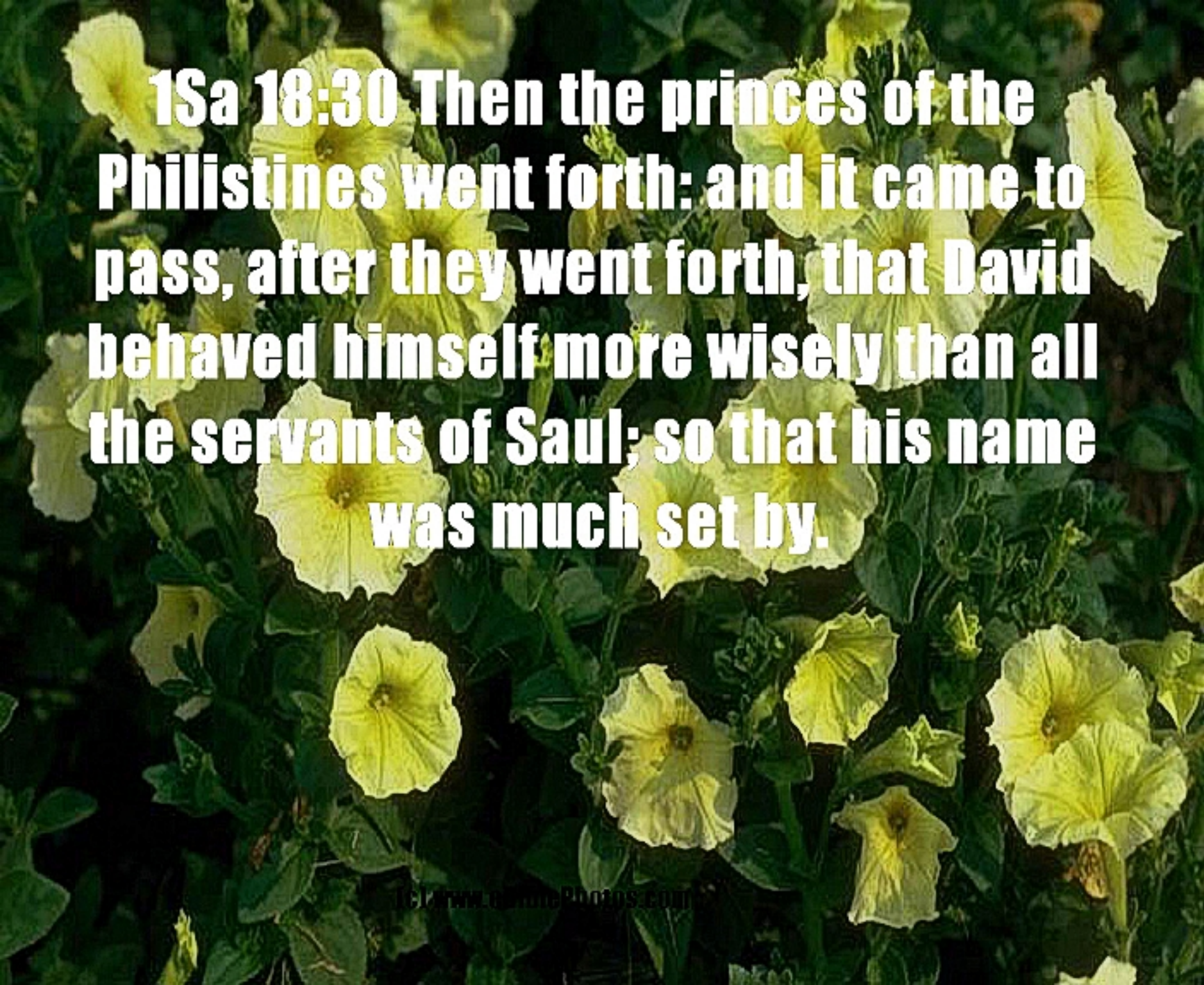
**Exo 01:10 Come on, let us deal wisely

and also in the sight of Saul's servants.**

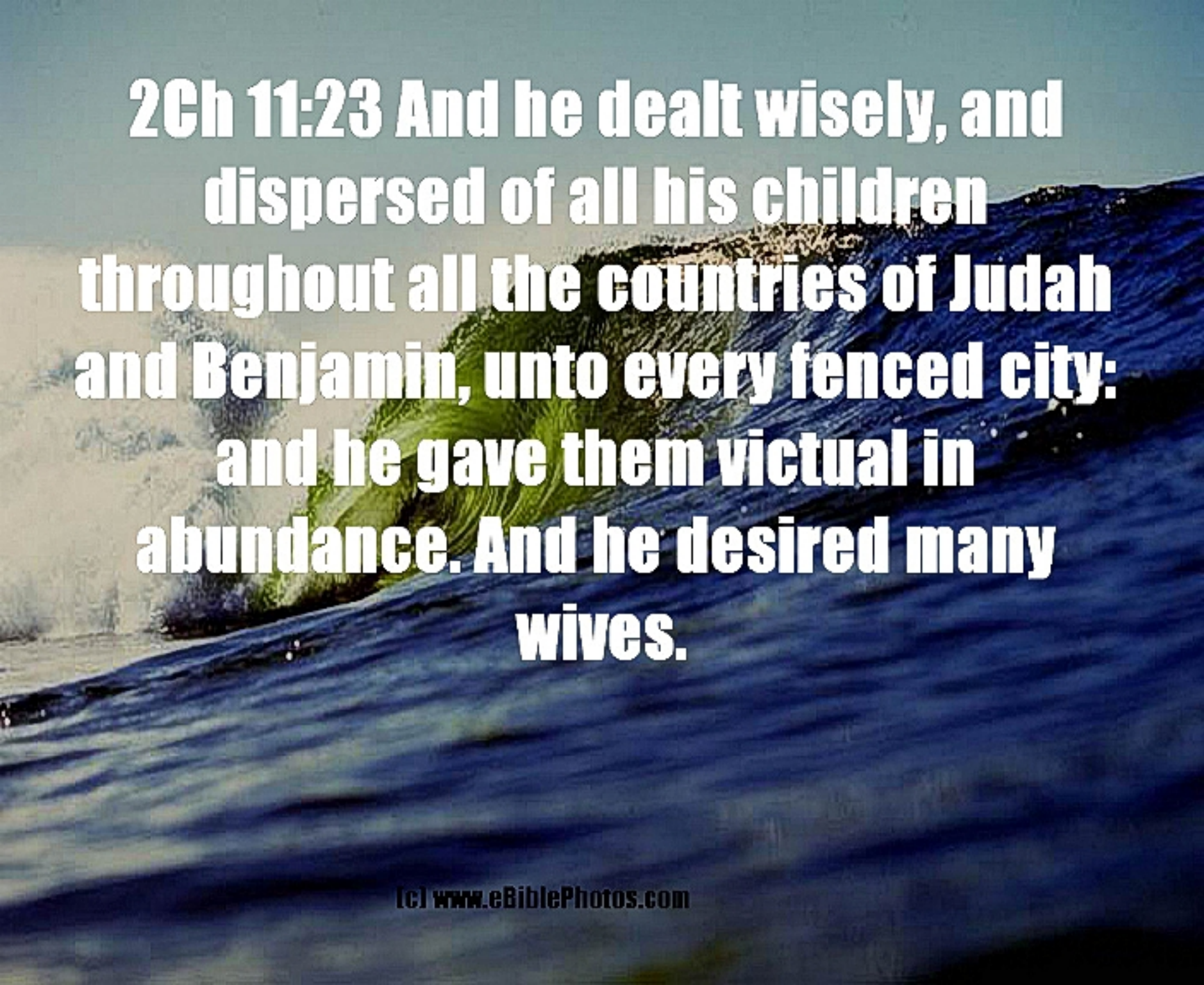
**1Sa 18:14 And David behaved himself

he was afraid of him.**



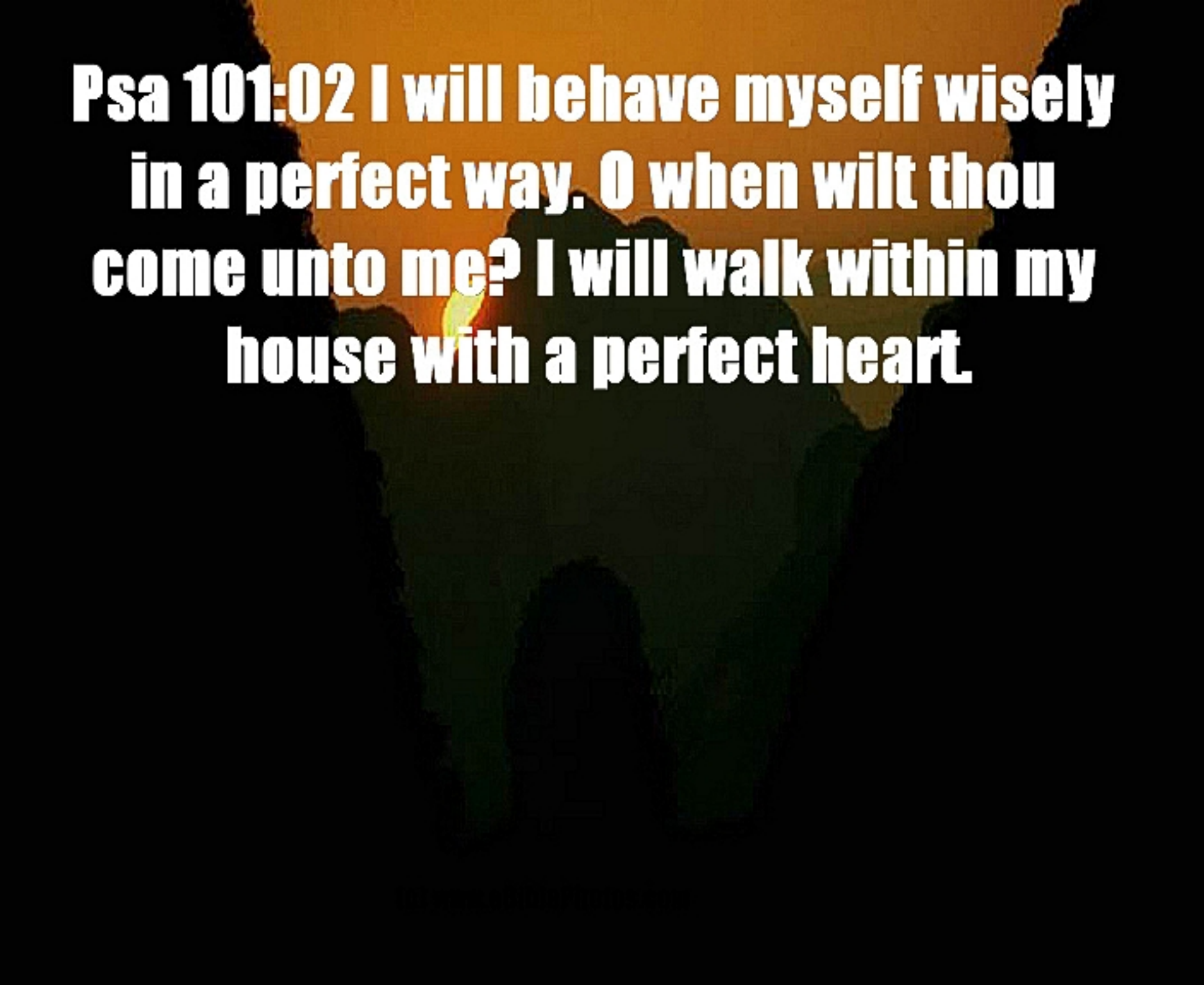

shall wisely consider of his doing.**



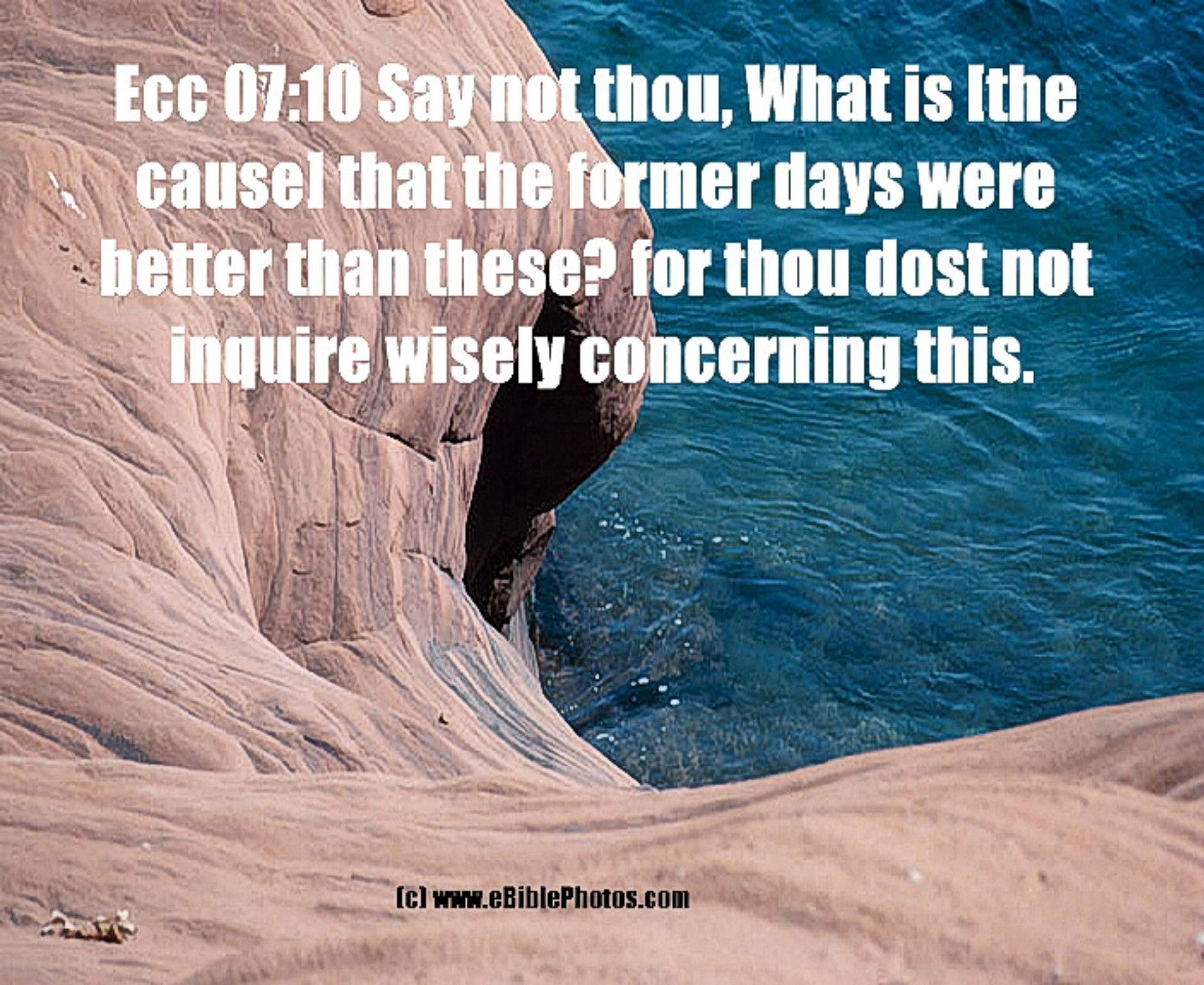

trusteth in the LORD, happy [is] he.**

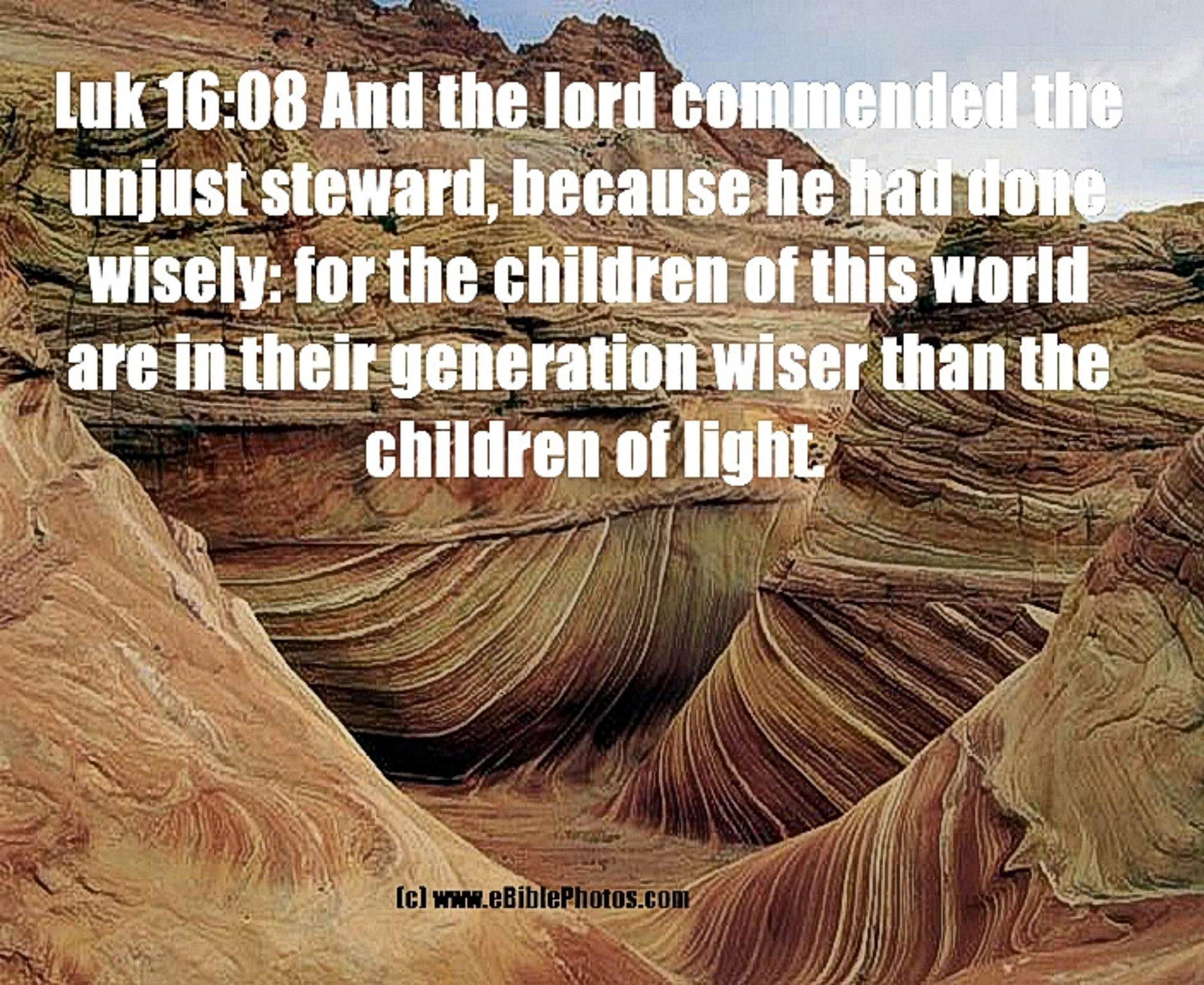
