**Num 25:14 Now the name of the
Israelite that was slain, [even] that
was slain with the Midianitish woman, I
was [Zimri], the son of Salu, a prince of
a chief house among the Simeonites.**

1Ki 16:09 And his servant Zimri, captain of half his chariots, conspired against him, as he was in Tirzah, drinking himself drunk in the house of Arza steward of his house in Tirzah.

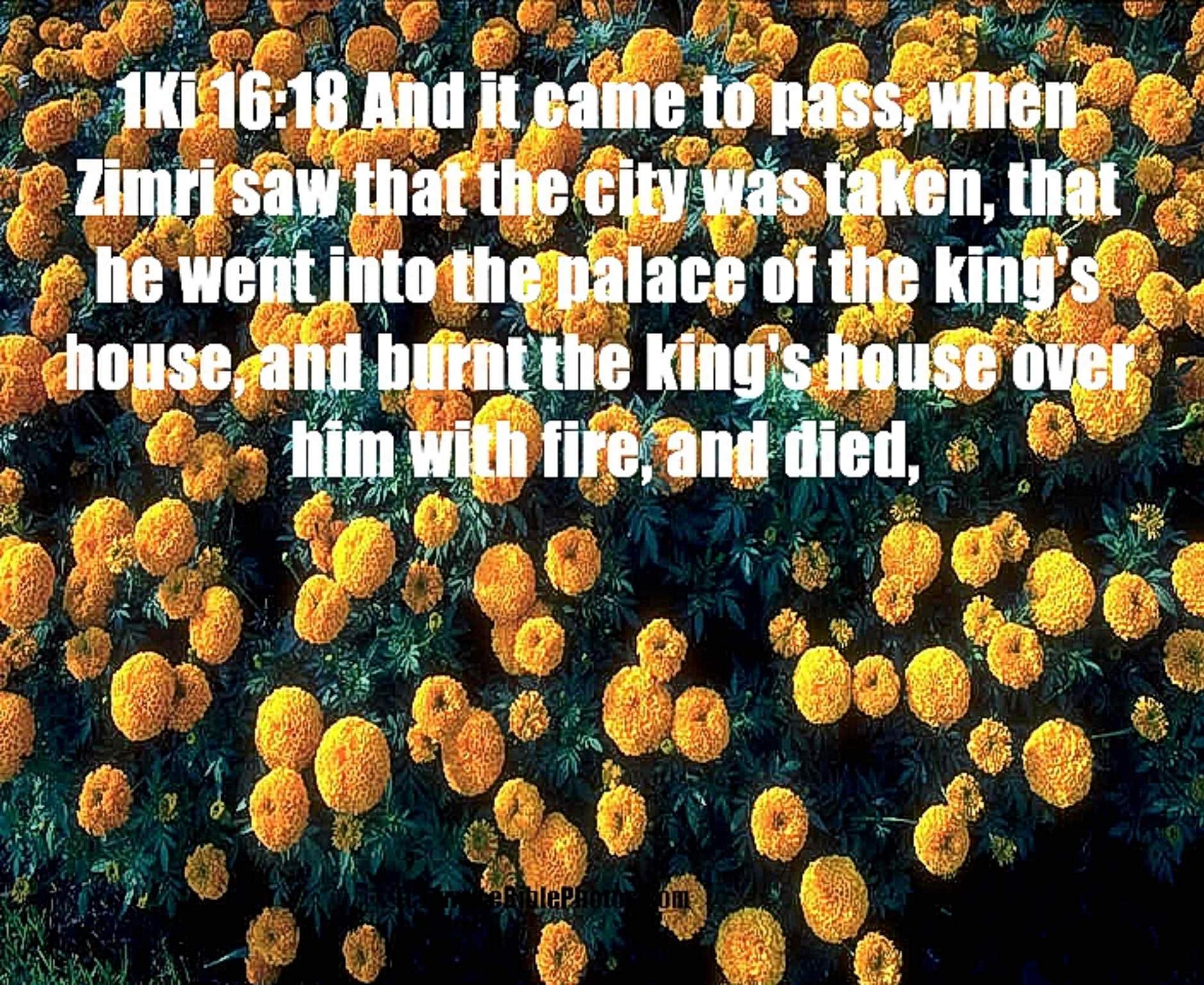
1Ki 16:10 And Zimri went in and smote him, and killed him, in the twenty and seventh year of Asa king of Judah, and reigned in his stead.
